A TEMPLIFIC STORM.

A fearful enow and wind storm from the cast has been raging since midnight last night all along the Quebec coast. The wind averages seventy miles an hour and the sea is tremendous and has crossed the highways and inundated the fields of all the parishes along the coast. The light house and telegraph offices there are now completely surrounded by raging waves. The roads are all undermined. The watch house and several buildings there and in that vicinity and at Rimouski have been carried away, besides a number of fences. Great numbers of persons have vacated their buildings at Rimouski and much excitement is felt regarding the tide of night. The track of the Inter-Colonial railway and the roadway have been washed away between Rimouski and Bic. No lives have been lost as far as known.

LATER-The signal and telegraph men have abandoned the station, having been compelled to take to boats. This is the greatest storm known in that vicinity for

A snow storm has prevailed in Reviere du Loup En Bas, Quebec, since last night, with a heavy wind from the northeast. The sea is sweeping over the wharf and has carried off a quantity of lumber. It has carried off a quantity of lumber. It has also swept away a store and the telegraph office and a house belonging to L. T. Pulza is not expected to stand another tide. The washout on the Inter-Colonial railway near Bic is one hundred feet long and twenty feet deep. Trains are unable to transfer to night.

At Rimenski, Ont., Nov. 5, the tides, which are usually very high at this season of the year, helped by a raging snow storm and a high northeast wind have swollen tremendously, and the sea which

swollen tremendously, and the sea which is now running is the heaviest that has visited this vicinity for years. The whole town of Rimouski is inundated and a large number of houses, barns, stables and wharves have been carried away. So far as heard no lives have been lost. People are leaving their houses in boats. The cattle have been turned loose and have taken to the interior of the country. Further fears are entertained for the next high tide. The loss so far is estimated at \$30,000.
