Mr. Middleton, superintendent of the mill, who was telephoned for to the Stavens house, where he boards, reached the scene about 3:15 a. m. in a hack which fortunately was at the hotel door, having just come in from the train. Mr. Howell, chief of the fire department, arrived soon after him and each took command at different extremi-ties of the mill, directing their energies to keep up the roof which would have carried with it the destruction of the mill, if it had fallen. The carpenter, shop was left to burn out, and one fire engine was shut off, as it di-minished the water so that the streams could not reach the roof. The two hose were kept steadily playing ou the girders and rafters, the roof between them being allowed to burn out. There was a momentary diversion when the fire from the carpenter shops extended with an adjacent shed, but the protection of the rafters was the main effort until about five o'clock, when the fire was under control and the building and machinery saved with only durings of consequence to the roof. AMOUNT OF THE LOSS. The carpenter shop must be rebuilt, only the walls being left standing. The tools, valuable rolling wall patterns and materials in the shop building were of course con-sumed. The damage is not yet estimated, but is not expected to reach \$5,000. It is fully rovered by insurance on the building for \$6,000 and on the machinery for \$12,000 in seven companies, in which the null is insured altogether for \$35,000.

WHAT CAUSED THE FIRE.

The origin of the fire is entirely unknown. As before stated there was no fire in the shop and it was locked up. It faces the railroad, but has a slate roof. Moreover, the fire burned out from the inside, as the outside of the door jambs on the mill side are not scorched. There was a small fire of bituminous coal in the mill against the brick wall dividing it from the carpenter shop. This was under the clay


