Statistics of Prussian Jews. From the London Times. Dr. Neumann, of Berlin, has recently compiled some interesting statistics respecting the Jews in Prussia in answer to the assertions of the anti-Semites that they are increasing at a dangerous rate. From figures from 1819 to 1880 it appears that in the former year the total population of Prussia was 19,349,000, of whom 123,000 were Jews, and of these 56,500 had no civil or political rights.
