

THE ROLLER SKATE. The Spread and Growth and Characteristics of a National Movement. From the New York Tribune.

Roller skating is becoming the national vogue. The craze over it is spreading rapidly, and is setting an every class of the community. A great army of shrewd men are earning money by providing facilities for it; while a goodly percentage of the public have forsaken all other forms of amusement and cleave to roller skating only.

Roller skating has many objectionable features, but its growth and popularity has a humorous and grotesque side as well. The clergy have properly enough called attention to the evils incident to it; though unfortunately their zeal has sometimes been greater than their discretion, as when one of them a few months ago denounced his horrid congregation that had not been for skating, rinks thousands of young people would never have fallen. He had heard casually that young people frequently fell in these places, and supposed that a fall into sin was meant. It is also well attested that many have gotten the pastime by reaching against it; and many rinks in country towns have attained their popularity largely in this way.

Roller skating has also been the cause of many deaths. In the city of Milwaukee, an Arizona editor decries the advance of the popular craze into that peaceful territory, and calls upon the citizens to oppose this epidemic. "We can fall," he adds, "easily enough now, without getting on those deuced roller skates."

In the midst of all this hubbub the verdict of the physician and the moralist on the evil propensities of roller skating is unambiguous, and the sun goes down on this most particular of creditable to the good sense of the American people; but the reaction will probably come some day.
