

ADVICE FOR THE FARMER.

EXPERIMENTS WITH PREMIUM SEED WHEAT AND OATS.

The Committee on Cereals, representing Chester County, on account of the Pennsylvania State Agricultural Society for the Year 1884, give these Results.

Of an impartial test by the above committee they reported on three different varieties of wheat, namely: Martin's Amber, Fulton, and Stubble Red.

Plot No. 1, Martin's Amber wheat, sowed September 25, in drill at rate of one and a half bushels the acre, and four hundred pounds Coe & Richmond's seed phosphate applied in drill with the wheat, yield, thirty-three and a quarter bushels the acre.

Plot No. 2, Fulton wheat, two bushels seed to the acre, and same treatment as to fertilizing, cultivation and time of planting; yield, thirty-one bushels eight pounds to the acre.

Plot No. 3, Stubble Red wheat, two bushels seed and same treatment as to fertilizing throughout the same as on plot No. 1 and 2; yield, thirty-four bushels two pounds.

The Martin's Amber wheat, although not the most prolific in this, our last report, has largely redeemed itself from its previous record in other tests.

OATS, OR SPRING CROP. With this particular cereal we have made quite a specialty, and obtained marked results. In our last report, we noticed the yield from two ounces Burpee's Welcome oats to be one hundred and sixty pounds.

This seed, with all due allowances for shrinkage and other contingencies, was sowed on plot No. 1, (two acres) on the 11th day of April last. The yield therefrom was one hundred and sixty bushels, of an extra quality of grain, which was awarded the first prize at the last exhibition of this society.

It is very probable that the quality of grain, speak volumes in its favor, and we hope to still continue its cultivation on other plots. Plot No. 2, Challenge oats, fifty-four bushels ten pounds the acre, weighing thirty-five pounds the bushel, or fifty-two bushels twenty-six pounds legal measure.

Plot No. 3, White Belgian oats, yielding forty bushels nine pounds the level bushel, or forty-two bushels seven pounds legal measure. The three above named varieties of oats we continued from last year's planting, having abandoned all others heretofore mentioned in our annual reports.

The white Russian oat has a stiff straw and is a vigorous grower, but its lateness of maturity conditions it for our planting. Thus far, our experience with this particular cereal—the contest, evidently, with us is between the Welcome and Challenge, both of which are rapid growers, very productive, of early maturity and extraordinary quality of grain.

Putting it on thick. From the Oxford Press. John D. Miller, of Upper Oxford, believes in heavy seeding. He recently sowed his oats, mixing with it, as is his custom, a good proportion of barley, and he used five bushels and a peck of seed per acre.

He regards his not getting an equal quantity of wheat last fall, as his field now looks a little too thin for 40 bushels per acre.

To Have Early Potatoes. From the Germantown Telegraph. It is sometimes desirable that the farmer have an early crop of potatoes, if not for market for his own use at least. To secure this desirable end it is necessary that there should be some manipulation of the seed, and this should be commenced in season so as to be ready as soon as the condition of the ground will admit of being planted.

The starting of potatoes depends upon the vigor of the sprouts, and this condition can be attained by bringing potatoes into a warm room, having plenty of light and without danger of freezing. It is not necessary that any dirt or earth should be necessary, since the potatoes may just as well be placed upon a board shelf. The object of this is to secure warmth and light, when the shoots will begin to start, first slender, but as they continue to develop they acquire greater vigor and so continue for a reasonable time, during which time the natural moisture of the potato is sufficient for the maintenance of the vigor of the sprouts.

This matter too long, they will finally begin to weaken and deteriorate. For that reason the potatoes to be started should be kept in a room that is not too hot, and that the room is fit and be in a state of advanced development. When the ground is prepared, cut the potatoes to a size of one and a half inches, and set them carefully in the soil, and potatoes will be produced about as much earlier as the time that has passed during the house development of the sprouts. This would hardly be practicable were many to be planted, but is better for garden use.
