COLUMBIAN PETITION FOR THE NEW COUNTY PRISON.

The Question Now Before the Discretion of Judge Livingston and Patterson-Licenses Under Discussion Before the Court.

Court met at 10 o'clock this morning for the transaction of current business and the consideration of applications for licenses for new saloons.

Prison Collector G. C. Kennedy presented the petition of County Commissioners Myers and Hartman for the erection of a new prison building.

PETITION FOR THE NEW JAIL. To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the County of Lancaster.

The petition of the undersigned members of the board of county commissioners of said county, respectfully represents that the present jail is a disgrace to the county.

That the state board of public charities have recently examined the Lancaster county prison and have reported that it is unsafe and unfit for the confinement of prisoners.

That the state board of public charities have recommended and insisted upon the erection of a new building at the earliest possible date.

That the board of inspectors of the said prison, at its regular meeting passed a resolution recommending the board of county commissioners to proceed to the erection of a new prison.

In view of these several recommendations the undersigned members of the board of county commissioners are constrained to ask the consent of your honorables for the erection of a new prison.

Henry G. Shirk desired a license for a hotel in West Hempfield township. It is the old West tavern and was a J. O. House for 32 years. A remonstrance signed by 29 men and 38 women was filed against the granting of the license.

Rev. H. B. Dobner, a pastor formerly living at Ironville, filed a remonstrance against the granting of the hotel license of John E. Irwin, at Cordelia. There was no testimony submitted to the court.
