The Philadelphia Postoflice. The inspectors report on the conduct of he Philadelphia postoffice is published at which have heretofore been diligently repmenting that the office was very badly anaged, and utterly inefficient by reason the substitution of raw Democratic Tks for experienced Republican officers. pecity of Philadelphia is oppressed with number of feeble Republican journals of .eater or less disposition to malicious mis representation of their political opponents. so that probably a general impression prevailed among the citizens that the postoflice was managed hadly and only with an eye to partisan service. This inspectors' report, which they read at length in the journals that have been telg them a very different tale, will show em that comparatively few changes have been made in the clerical force, and that the new appointees have been found by the inspectors to be intelligent and efficient. The complaints that have been made against the office are declared generally to have been of a trivial character and such as would be caused by a delay of trains or other occasion that could not be provided against, and which happened as frequently under the old management, without cause ing comment then as there was no partisan end to be gained by abusing the postmaster. And some well founded complaints had their origin in the malicious endeavor of some old employes in the office to bring its management into discredit by misleading and misdirecting the new clerks and tath pering with the carriers' packs. If I have ommended that any clerk found goally o such practices should be dismissed. The

recommendation does not go far chough. If any such things are but reasonably suspected to be done in the office there should be a wholesale cleaning out of the infected quarters.

Postmaster Harrity has been very patient under the exceedingly ungenerous and malignant attacks that have been made upen him and must enjoy greatly the confasion to which this report puts his foes. it is not only a complete vindication o himself, but it puts upon the Republican friends of his malignant as ailants the responsibility for the complaints against the postoflice which they have been industriously making. Their chickens have come home to roost. We have never, in our experience of journalism, section ything to equal the mean malice of the Philadel phia Press in its treatment of Postmaster Harrity, whom it well knew to be a young man of high intelligence, honor and character. He came into the man agement of a great administrative office, without much experience in business administration, and was entitled to exp ct at least decent consideration until he had an opportunity to get the swing of it. Perhaps he may be proud that he was treated so harsbly; taking it as a tribute to a vigor that was justly feared.

The Cost of Gas. A proposition is made to the Philadel

phia councils by a New York company to put an acceptable illuminating gas in the gas holders of the city for from twenty to twenty-five cents per thousand feet. And it is said that a Standard oil man has declared that their sort of gas can be made for fourteen cents per thousand feet. There

is nothing new in that. It has long been known that the cost of manufacture of illuminating gas is very small. If it was not for the cost of distribution and administration, the leakage, dividends, and surplus laid away, the price of gas to the consumer would be very small. As we have heretofore said it has long been furnished by the government at West Point, made out of coal that costs live or six dollars a ton, for seventy-five cents

per thousand feet, which covers all the sost and leaves a handsome surplus. Philadelphia's gas should not have cost her people who own it, fifty cents per thousand feet at any time during the past twenty years.

Turkey with Russia.

Turkey seems to have come to an understanding with Russia, since her representative in Bulgaria is backing up Russia's demands. The situation is a strange one.
