Blondes and Brunettes

From the London Standard. The business of examining the hair, eye and skin of 6,858,827 pupils is not a hotiday task to be lightly undertaken on a spare afternoon. How long it occupies is not stated, but examination of this number of little boys and girls has been made in Ger-many by Professor Virchow; but it is not very evident that his industrious anthropolo-gistic labors are rewarded by results. He has only found out what a tolerably observant traveller might have discovered for him-self, and the precise figures he gives are of little or no practical value. It appears that 43 3-36 per cent, of children in Northern Ger-43 3-36 per cent, of children in Northern Germany are blondes. 32 5-28 per cent, are blondes in Middle Germany, and 24 5-18 per cent, in the south. The river Main, it is pointed out, thus becomes an anthropological line of significance. In general, the farther south one goes the more brunettes one meets—South Havaria mustering but 14 per cent, blondes. Among 74,399 Hebrew children another table of figures shows the pure brunettes outnumbered the pure blondes threefold. Whereas the relation of the blondes to the brunettes among the Christians is 31.8 to 14; that among the Jewish children is as 11.29 to 42. The tolerably observant traveller afore-42.
