

DEVELOPING A COW FOR BUTTER

Some Information That Will Be Appreciated by Those Interested in It.

EDS. COUNTRY GENTLEMEN—I have a 1,000 pound cow and wish to know how each day to produce the richer milk, and also if anything else is necessary to produce the best results.

U. C. W. S. does not say what the quality of the cow's milk is at present. From the fact of her giving 18 quarts daily, it may be inferred that her milk is not rich.

For the encouragement of your correspondent let us state that we have several instances, improved cows that required 25 to 28 pounds of milk for one of butter, so that 20 pounds of milk would make one of butter at the same time saving as the larger amount was required—but we were never able to accomplish it in less than two years.

This has a nutritive ratio of 15.8. It will do very well to begin with, but after a month or so, the nutritive ratio should be raised. He can feed no straw or corn fodder.

How to Build a Pen House. A correspondent of Farm, Stock and Home advises to excavate into a hill facing south, and build the ends and rear of stone laid with cement.
