Named Commissioner of Patents in Place of Montgomery, Resigned. WASHINGTON, April 7.—The president this afternoon announced the appointment of Benton J. Hall, of Iowa, to be commissioner of patents, vice Montgomery, resigned.

Murderer McCabe Hanged. Governor Beaver has issued a respite for Bernard McCabe, the Wayne county murderer, until May 20. This means a further hearing before the board of pardons, when another strong effort will be made to change the death sentence to imprisonment for life.

Deaths of Isaac Sprope. Isaac Sprope, aged about 74, died this morning at 10 o'clock in a stroke which prostrated him. Mr. Sprope was a native of Pennsylvania, and was the son of Emanuel Sprope, who located on this place in the beginning of the present century. His parents and sister died three children, namely, Isaac, wife of J. Ryan, of this place, and a single son, Isaac, who resides in Pennsylvania; Emanuel, who was a well known man, died two years ago, and Isaac, who died several years ago.
