GULLER'S CURATIVE MEDICINE.
The French Chamber of Deputies Voted Against
His Propositions.
The debate on the report of the budget
committee, which demands a reduction in
the estimates submitted by the government,
was begun in the French Chamber of Deputies
Tuesday, M. Dauphin, minister of
Finance, declared that in his proposition the
government had effected all the reforms
which were possible, and had re-estab-
lished the financial equilibrium through the
income and alcoholic taxes. The country
knew that the government was acting more
in consonance with parliamentary traditions
than was the case with any other govern-
ment that had preceded it. (Applause from
the Left and part of the Centre.)
M. Douage attacked the financial policy
of the government and declared that the
committee could not accept the govern-
ment's proposals for increased taxation and
expenditures.
Premier Goblet said the present financial
situation was the result of the mistakes
of past governments. He was ready
to work with the committee with the view
of providing efficacious remedies. The govern-
ment desired to balance the budget with-
out fresh taxation, if necessary. He reproached
the committee with demanding reforms
which it knew to be impracticable from a
budget point of view. (Applause from the
Left and part of the Centre.)
He found nothing that justified the com-
mittee's hostility either in the government's
internal policy or in its foreign policy, neither
of which was lacking in wisdom and firm-
ness. He was ready to co-operate again with
the committee or to leave the Chamber
might do. (Applause.)
The Chamber, by a vote of 275 to 259,
rejected the proposals of the government, and
proceeded to discuss the order of the day. M.
Goblet then announced that the cabinet
would resign. As soon as this announce-
ment had been made the members of the
cabinet left the Chamber. A resolution
was proposed by M. Douage that the govern-
ment should be held responsible for the
strategic necessity of adopting new plans
for retrenchment. The resolution was
adopted by a vote of 312 to 143, and the
Chamber then adjourned Monday next.

An Imperial Fraud.
Professors Brashear and Vary of the Pitts-
burg observatory have had a rather interest-
ing experience with a comet. They have
claimed to be a professor in the royal observ-
atory of Brazil. He was travelling in
Europe and America, he said, and had been
instructed by the emperor to visit all the prom-
inent observatories and all the places where
astronomical instruments are manufactured.
The visitor was shown through the manufac-
tory and was then taken over to the manufac-
