The record up to Saturday was held by the Umbria of the same line, whose best time was made in May, 1887, when she covered the same distance in six days, four hours and tweive minutes. The number of miles covered cach day by the Etruria is as follows: May 28, 455 miles; May 29, 458 miles; May 30, 495 miles; May 31, 485 miles; June 1, 503 miles; June 2, 457 miles. No rough weather was experienced during the trip, and but little fog was met with off the Banks of Newfoundland.
