Men Imported from England. The first witness before the congress Men Imported from England.

The first witness before the congressional investigating committee in Boston on Tuesday, was James Danby, of Lewrence, who was induced to come from England by H. G. Johnson, the latter offering to pay his pavenge and those of his five children. He was promised large wages. Johnson was the agest of Prince, Smith & Co., and John R. Bolles & Bro. The witness thought there were thirty five people in the party which sailed for America, all procured by Johnson. When he arrived in Boston the witness was examined by a doctor, but no officer asked him if he came under centract. The party were taken to the Cunard office, where they were saked to sign a document the nature of which the witness did not know. Witness signed it, and then went to Forge Village, where he worked fifteen months for About & Co., who did not pay him as much as agreed upon by Johnson. Seven-eighths of the population of Forge Village is imported labor, and the tenements in which employee are forced to live are not habitable. Wages were better here than in England, but living was higher. Several other witnesses gave evidence similar in character.
