REVOLT OF THE GERMANS. Spisode of the Maryland and rennyl-

rania Houndary Lias Dispute. Mr. L. P. Hennighausen read a paper last night before the Gorman Historical society on the revolt of the Germans against the on the revolt of the Germans against the government of Maryland in 1730 34. After rev ewing the political and religious troubles which caused many hardy Germans to leave the Palatinate and other states in South Germany in the beginning of the eighteenth century, and giving some account of their settlement in Pennsylvania, he said that their offspring still form an important part of the population of York and Lancaster counties. Some of them still speak the German language intermixed with English, and they are known as "Pennsylvania German,"

"Some of the atters crossed the Susquession in 1720 and built the towns of Manheim, Weet Manheim and Heide's terg, though it was not until 1735 that the Indian tribes gave up their claims to the lind. During the boundary line dispute between Maryland and Pennsylvania the Germans who were in the disputed territory suffered hardships. Thimas Cresar, a captain of the Maryland militia and a justice of the peace, threatened everybody unvilling to recognize the jurisdiction of Maryland. When Pennsylvania authorities attempted to arrest him he killed Daputy Sheriff Knowles Dant, January 30, 1734, and in September, 1735, he and his followers captured Sheriff Robert Buchanan of Lancaster county, but had to release him by order of Governor Og'e, of Maryland. In 1736 a number of the Germans were driven from their property by him, and at last recognized temporarily the Maryland jurisdiction. When they discovered, however, that they were still in Pennsylvania territory they decided to recognize the government of that province, and sent letters to the Maryland and Pennsylvania authorities announcing their intention.

"The governor of Maryland proclaimed them rebels and ordered out the militia of Baltimore and Cecil counties. They assembled September, 1738, on Col. Nationiel Rigby's farm 300 mounted and armed men, with Col. Elward Hall and Captains Paca and Guest. Sheriff William Hammond, of Baltimore county. with Col. E. Jward Hall and Captains Paca and Guest. Sheriff William Hammond, of Baltimore county, was among them. They entered the present York county, but fearing to be overpowered by the Germans, who met them, they returned to Maryland. Governor Ogle granted a petition to Charles Higgenbothem, Henry Mundes, Edward Lee and forty nine others, asking that the lands of the Germans be divided among them, and arms were sent to Rigby's farm. "A plan to make snother expedition into Pennsylvania was defeated, and November 23, 1736, the sheriff of Lancaster county, with twenty four men, after firing Cresap's house, arrested him and kept him prisoner at Philadelphia for over a year. He after-wards removed to Frederick county, whore, at the age of 106, he died a rich man and highly esteemed. The hostilities were continued until August 18, 1737, when a royal order was received by the governors of both provinces that all prisoners should be released and the warfare should cease."
