O'ROOLE'S NEW NOSE.

A Chorus Singer Tries a New Method of Beautif, beg the Face.

The three turbanated boncs and the septum which were crushed, have apparently healed in proper position and the oriental nose has been much improved in shape. On Wednesday evening Mr. O'Toole appeared before the members of the New York Medical association, and Dr. Wyeth delivered a lecture upon what he called "a beautiful case." The removal of the needle followed and the petient will walk the streets this week a much handsomer man than he was a month ago, when his nose was somewhat lopeided and pudgy, even before the disastrous "argument" with the "cabby."

It is believed to be the first complete case of the kind on record and is attracting the medical profession from all parts of the country.
