Her arrival at Fortress Monroe on the dreadful night of the sinking of the Cumberland and the blowing up of the Congress was providential to the comprehension of living men. Her coming, had it been tun hours later, would have been too late. The contractors did their work and the Monitor did here. They were paid on sight and pocketed the small lose, but Mr. Griswold and Mr. Winslow were abundantly satisfied. A revolution in marine architecture marked the century and Capt. John Ericeson's name was carved in enduring letters upon the door plate. The Monitor was constructed at Mystic, Connecticut. The plates were rolled at Troy, New York. The whole cost was \$275,000.


