AN IMPORTANT DECISION. The Pennsylvania Railroad Must Pay Consequential Damages.

A decision of considerable importance to Pennsylvania along the line of the Pennsylvania railroad was rendered by the United States supreme court at Washington on Monday.

George E. Dunson was the owner of large timber manufacturing works running from Twenty-third and Filbert streets to the Schuylkill river, Philadelphia, besides certain tracts on the river front. All this property lay to the north of the elevated road where the railroad company occupied the full width of Filbert street.

The charter of the company gives it the right to take whatever property necessary for the conduct of its business, compensation to be made for any property taken. Prior to 1874 the court decisions repeatedly held that the railroad company exempted the company from the payment for property injured but not actually taken.

As a final resource the Pennsylvania railroad company brought suit against the plaintiff and Hon. Wayne MacVeigh the railroad company, holding that there was no such contract on the part of the state as exempted the railroad from the payment of consequential damages.
