

A WOMAN ARRESTED. THE ALLEGED WIDOW OF LOUIS F. SIMONS HELD AT COLUMBIA.

Philadelphia, Dec. 25.—'Louis F. Moore' was the alias of an employe of the Pennsylvania railroad who was killed in the west yards at this place on December 11. His name was Louis F. Simons, of Heuvelton, St. Lawrence county, N. Y., and according to this place in March last accompanied by his alleged wife, they stopped at the Franklin house a few days and then went to house keeping. Their baggage bore evidence of an extended European trip. The Police Gazette of March 7 contained pictures of the runaway Simons and the woman who it was claimed, was the wife of Frank Lanning, of Heuvelton, St. Lawrence county, N. Y. A correspondence followed and the man was to have been arrested, but was before the time fixed for same. The remains were taken to Heuvelton, N. Y., for burial, being accompanied by the man's wife. The wife returned to town to dispose of her effects and was arrested last evening by Officer Wittich on telegraphic advice as follows: 'Watch parties as far as possible. Parties have started today. F. Lanning.' The dispatch is dated Heuvelton, N. Y. The father of the young man is also here and was with the woman last night at the Squire Evans. The woman is about 40 years of age, light complexion and is quite portly. She is dressed neatly, wears a necklace, earring and earrings. She is a much abused woman; that she has not taken any but her own money left by her father's estate and that she has not lived with her former husband for several years. The P. R. R. officials of this place have stated that the relief benefits of the deceased young man will be paid to Mrs. Moore, who is her former name. She was well received in town and bore evidence of refinement and education of more than ordinary character. Mrs. Moore, as well as the father of the man, claim that she has been divorced for eight years. The woman was taken by Officer Wittich to his home, where she was kept under surveillance during the night. This is the way the case stands at noon today, and if the parties do not arrive today the woman will be released. Chippeta Castle, No. 58, K. O.
