NO MORE WAR.

The following resolution was signed and presented in the Pan-American conference on Wednesday by the delegates of the Argentine Republic and Brazil.

Considering that the international policy of the present conference should be characterized by principles and declarations of mutual security and respect among all the states of the continent...

First.—That international arbitration is a principle of American public law.

Second.—That the armed occupation of the disputed territories, without having first tried arbitration, should be considered as an act of aggression...

Third.—That the arbitration may take place in an impartial form whenever the states agree to the election of only one arbitrator.

Fourth.—That the election of arbitrators shall not be subject to any limitations or exclusions.

Fifth.—That the recent declarations are applicable not only to differences which may in future arise in the relations of the States...

SIXTH.—In case of war the triumph of arms shall not convey any rights to the territory of the vanquished.

SEVENTH.—The treaties of peace which put an end to the hostilities may fix the boundary indemnification which the belligerent states may owe to each other...

EIGHTH.—Acts of conquest, whether they represent the object had in view or are the consequence of war, shall be considered as in violation of the public law of America.
