

Respecting Big Game of Money. John Steinmetz, a paper-hanger in Philadelphia, expects shortly to secure a large fortune. The estate was left by the deceased's great-grandfather and in principle in money, amounting to \$10,000, which has been accumulating at 3 per cent. compound interest in the banks of London. The fortune originally was made in shipping and manufacturing years ago. It was advertised in the papers throughout the United States that an inquiry was being made into the estate of James Moffit, but only two of them survive, William Moffit and Anna Baldwin, of Union county Ohio.
