

TWO YOUNG WOMEN KILLED.

They Jump Wildly from a Carriage During a Runaway. A runaway occurred on Saturday afternoon on the boulevard between Newark and Elizabeth by which two young women lost their lives. Miss Mary E. Carrie and Lottie Tyler, three sisters, Newark, started for a drive to Elizabeth in a two-wheeled surrey. While passing on the boulevard, the team of horses attached to the vehicle took fright from the discharge of guns by the East Side Gun club, whose members were having a pigeon shooting match. The horses became unmanageable and finally ran away, despite the exertions of the colored coachman. The young women lost their presence of mind and leaped wildly from the carriage. Mary E. Tyler, age thirty-six, who is a teacher in the Lawrence street public school in Newark, struck on her head on the macadamized road, crushing her skull and badly lacerating her face. She was picked up insensible and carried to the house where she died half an hour later. Her sister Carrie, age twenty-six, who is a teacher in the Summer avenue school, was likewise unconscious when taken up. Dr. James S. Green, after examining Miss Carrie, said that her case was serious, as she was suffering from concussion of the brain. She died a few hours later. The third lady in the carriage, Miss Lottie Tyler, escaped with a few slight bruises. The horses ran only a few hundred feet after the accident when they were stopped. The ladies were taken to Elizabeth, and the sister who had escaped was taken to her home heart-broken. The men who did the shooting will be arrested.
