

VAUX AND VICTORY.

Richard Vaux, May 12.—Richard Vaux was this morning nominated by acclamation by the Third congressional district Democratic convention as a candidate to fill the vacancy caused by the death of Samuel J. Randall.

The special election in the Third district will be held on May 20. Vaux is being nominated to take a vote for a candidate, the convention adopted the following resolutions:

Resolved, That the great and varied industries of Philadelphia, and the manufacturing, commercial, and laboring population, absolutely demands a tariff reform that will give our industries free raw materials, and reduce the cost of living, and that we demand that the people shall be kept by Congress by free raw materials for our industries, and that we demand that the necessities of life and the reduction of all tariff taxes, which have fostered monopoly combines.

Richard Vaux, lawyer and politician, was born Dec. 19, 1818, and is a son of Hon. John Vaux, who was a judge of common pleas court of Philadelphia, and one of the original signers of the Declaration of Independence.
