HIGH LICENSE ON TRIAL. et Case to Be Made in the United

States Supreme Court.

Charles Sliverman, of Leechburg, pretited a petition in the United States court

The petition continues that he is informed and believes said arrest and commitment were in violation of and without authority of law. He further represents he is and was the agent of the Cincinnati Brewing company, of Hamilton, O., and that the company consigned from that place in Ohio to themselves, the Cincinnati Brewing company, at Leechburg, in Armstrong county, in care of the petitioner, their agent, a quantity of beer stamped "original packages," which the petitioner received at Leechburg, andas the agent of the company sold as the goods of the Cincinnati Brewing company as stamped, "original packages," in the same packages, in the same condition as received by him from the company, unopened, unaltered, unchanged, with the stamps unbroken, to the citizens of Leechburg and vicinity.

He further declared he has sold the beer in no other way, and was not in any way interested in the liquors than as agent for the Cincinnati Brewing company. He also says, under these facts and others which he is ready to show to the court, he is not amenable and subject to the laws of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and the quarter sessions of Armstrong county has no jurisdiction in this case. He asks that a writ of habeas corpus may issue, and says he is in custody in violation of the laws of the United States. The court made the following order:
