BALTIMORE, April 19.—Drummond, the man who was arrested a month since on the charge of participating in the terrible murder of the young man of Georgetown, Md., on the night of February 27th, has made a confession disclosing the true authors of the crime. He says that the man named Murphy, who was killed, was the proprietor of the Kent County Hotel, and that he and Taylor, were the perpetrators of the murder. He denies that he had anything to do with it. He only knew of the conspiracy of others for the commission of the crime.
