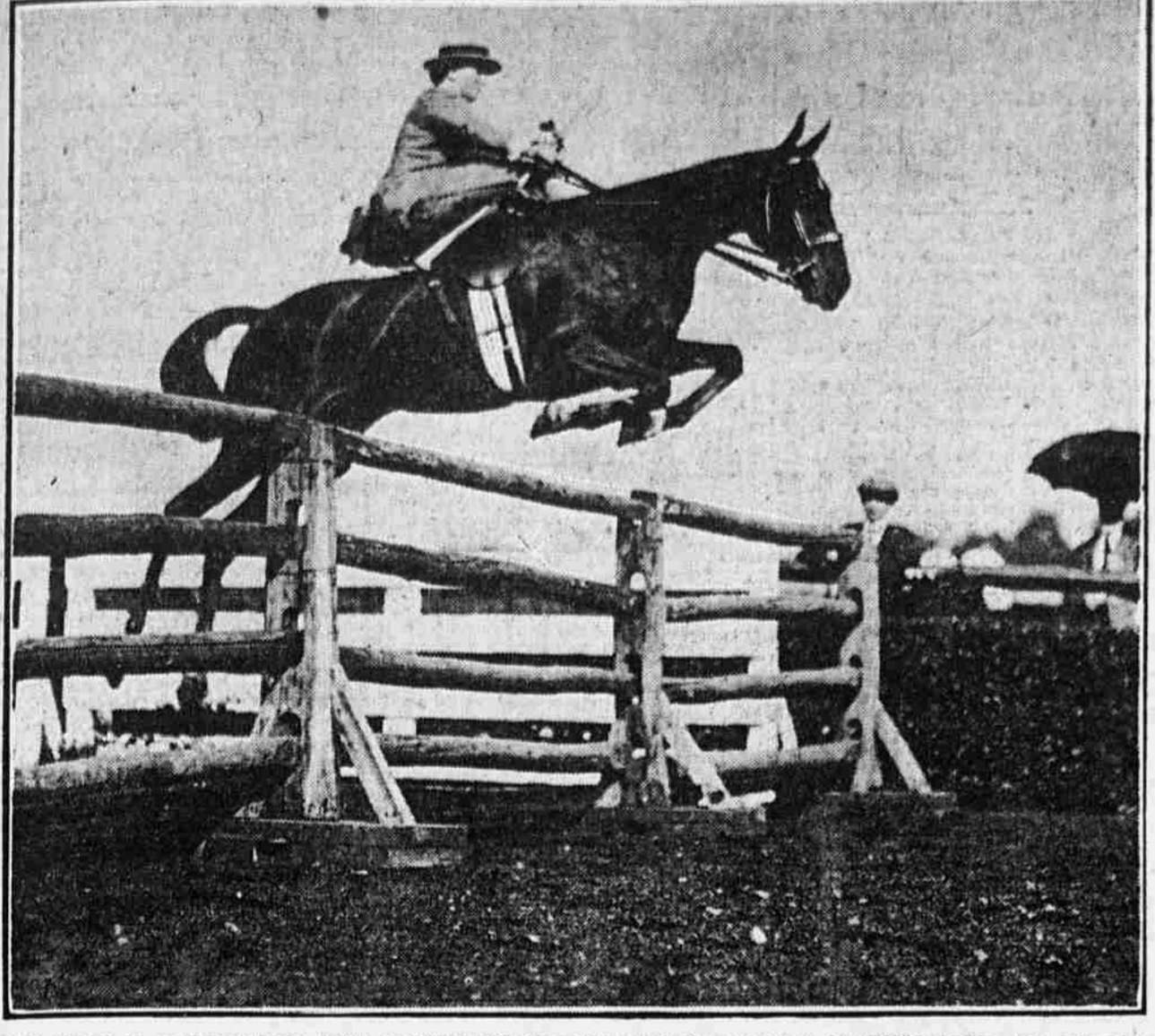

LIGHT ON BIPARTISAN "DEALS" DUE TODAY IN PENROSE PROBE

Reorganization Democrats Point to Affiliations Between Old Guard and Liquor Ring of Machine.

Bipartisan deals between the Old Guard Democrats and the Republican Organization in Philadelphia through a communion of interests in the "liquor ring" are expected to be brought to light before the Senate Committee on Privileges and Elections when that committee meets in Washington today to decide upon an investigation of Senator Penrose's primary campaign "slush fund."

Reorganizers point out that the Old Guard Democratic City Committee, which frequently has been a party to bipartisan deals, is bound to the Republican Organization and the liquor interests by financial and marriage ties through its chairman, H. Gordon Bromley.

WILSON TURNS DOWN JERSEY DEMOCRATS' SECOND TERM BOOST

President Says Such Action Would Take Advantage of Present Extraordinary Situation for Personal Gain

WASHINGTON, Sept. 25.—President Wilson today declined to allow the Democrats of New Jersey to endorse him for a second term. He believed that such an endorsement might look as if he were "taking advantage of the extraordinary situation now existing to gain some personal advantage through such an expression of confidence by them."

GERMANS CAPTURE HEIGHTS ON MEUSE AS ALLIES FALTER

Invaders Push Lines Forward as They Maintain Terrific Bombardment of Forts on French Right Wing—Rheims Is Again Shelled.

PARIS, Sept. 25. French forts on the right of the long battle line underwent terrific bombardment today. German forces capturing heights on the Meuse River, occupying Varennes and marching on St. Mihiel. As a result of these successes, the invaders now threaten Verdun on three sides.
