

FELINE HOBO SOCIETIES BATTLE FOR \$31,000 FUND

Layers of Two Nations in Fight Over Will. NEW YORK, Feb. 3.—To decide which of two coteries of cats and kittens, resident in London, England, should receive a bequest of \$31,000 by the will of Miss Caroline G. Ewen, of this city, lawyers of two nations filed a report in the Surrogate Court yesterday. Testimony covering 105 typewritten pages leaves the question unsettled. The "hobo" cats of London assert their right to the bequest as members of the London Institution for Lost and Starving Cats. They are challenged by the aristocratic cats who, it is said, have the patronage of the royal family as members of the Animal Rescue League, which is a subsidiary of the Royal Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals. Miss Ewen left the bequest to "The Cats' Home, Miss Kate Remming, London." Four hundred and seventy-nine thousand cats have been rescued by the societies.

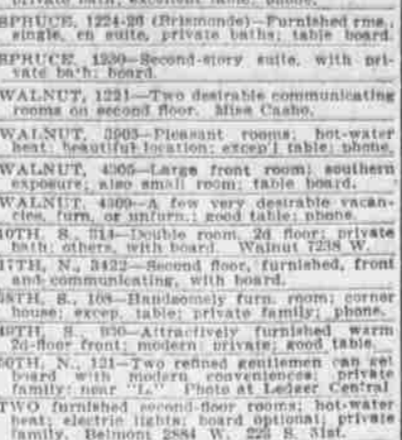

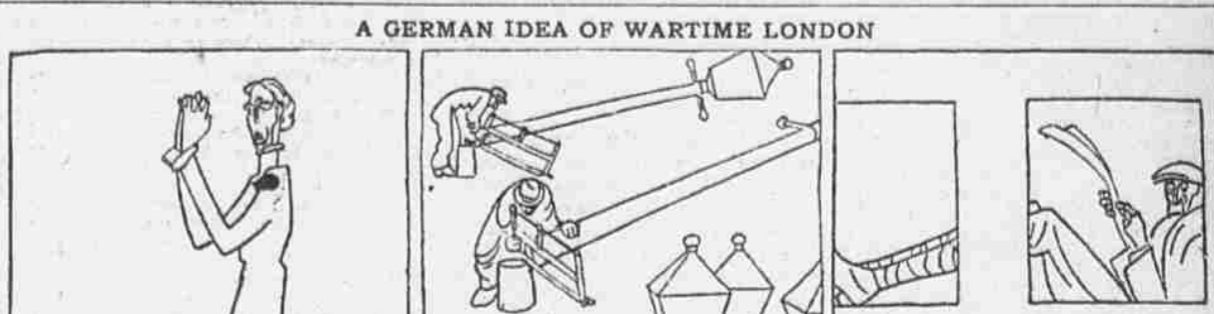
