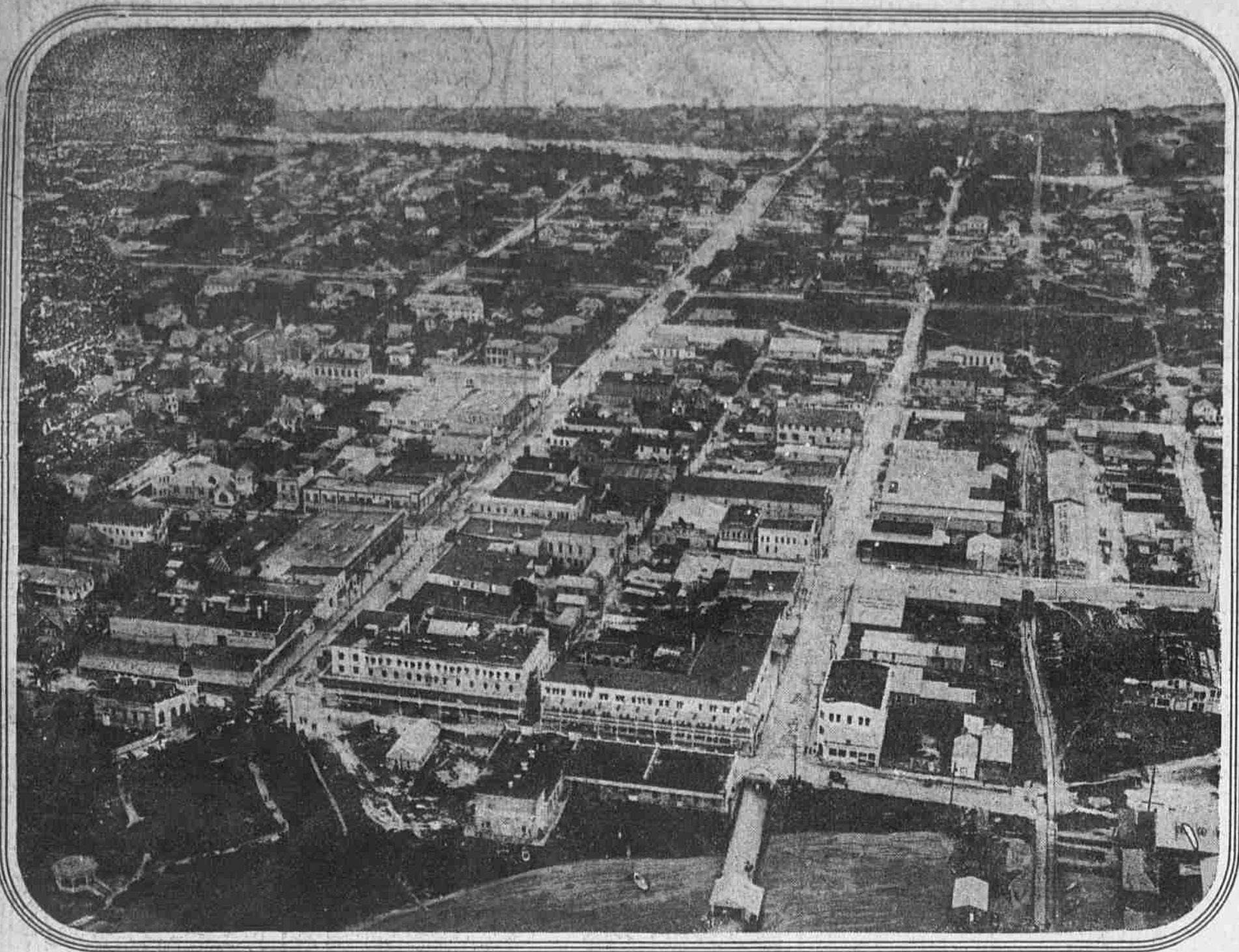




A PAGE OF PALM BEACH AND THE AMUSEMENTS IN FAVOR WITH THE SOCIETY FOLK WINTERING THERE

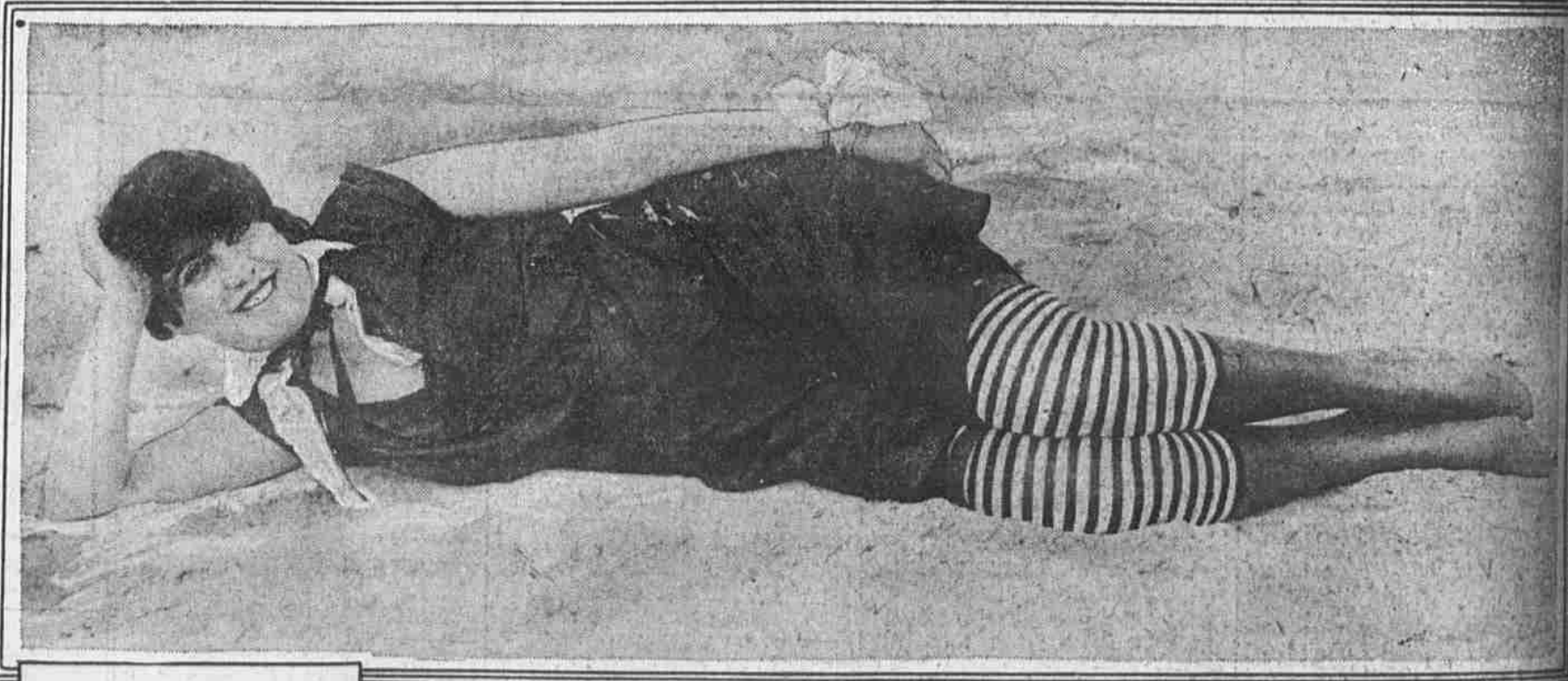
