
CAVALRY IS HIGHLY EFFICIENT BRANCH OF THE SERVICE

KING VICTOR EMMANUEL


Young monarch, whose capabilities will get their first severe test if his people go to war against the other two Powers of the Triple Alliance.



ALPINE CHASSEURS OF TWO COUNTRIES MEET


An Italian mountain soldier, with the stiff feather on his cap, exchanges fraternal greetings on the border line with a Frenchman belonging to a similar corps.

The Italian fleet is declared to be assembled and fully equipped for battle at a moment's notice, while Austria is concentrating her fleet at Pola to await the declaration of war.




THE SAN GIORGIO
