

## MADE IN CANADA CAMPAIGN AFFECTING U. S. BUSINESS

Motto Adopted to Stimulate Home Manufacture in Dominion.

MONTREAL, March 25.—The motto, "Made-in-Canada" already has had several effects, says the Montreal Gazette. First, it has stimulated home manufacturers very markedly. Secondly, it has given concern to many United States manufacturers who, before the advent of "Made-in-Canada," did a large business with us. Thirdly, it has led not a few of the same manufacturers to resolve to establish plants all over the Dominion.

O. W. Curtis, the Canadian Pacific Railroad industrial agent here, just returned to Montreal from a trip to the states to ascertain that Canada stands to gain in every way from the application of the motto "Made-in-Canada," coupled at the same time with the new war imposed by our Government—which imposes the case of United States goods, comes to 10% per cent.

"I found," said Mr. Curtis, "that the 'Made-in-Canada' motto had caused a considerable falling off in the business we transact with the United States, for which we in our certain articles, for the simple reason that we had commenced to make these things ourselves. Then again, there was the new tariff, which had an intimidating effect. So that I had many inquiries with respect to locations in Canada for branches of American manufacturers."

"This is bound to do us good. Towns and cities will not prosper without manufacturing. Now, we can tell American manufacturers all about locations, tax exceptions, water power, electric powers, population, markets, and so forth. We have all the information classified, ready for instant use."
