

MYSTERY IS SOLVED BY DEATH OF "GRANNY"

Aged Woman, Friend of Children, Always Kept One Room in Apartments Locked.

Why did "Granny" McGinty have a secret room? And that room so clean and neat, whereas the rest of her apartments was noted, if anything, for its general air of slovenliness?

This "mystery" still puzzled some of her neighbors when they learned that the aged woman had been found dead today in her attic, at 539 De Lancey street. The front room of the fourth floor was in a state that defied description—every thing was out of place, if not a lot of children were scampering about there and putting things out of place—playing at pillow fights, perhaps.

But when the men who found "Granny's" body, Myer Black, 928 North Sixth street, and Louis Kaplan, 509 De Lancey street, searched the apartments, they came to a room in the back part of the fourth floor which was almost uncannily neat and clean. There everything was in place—it was as correct as a Dutch kitchen.

Those who knew Margaret McGinty, who lived in her attic for 40 years, a recluse except for her little visitors, explained the "mystery." She had no friends but the children, and she loved them. One little girl brought her soup every day of the last two weeks of "Granny's" life, when she was too ill to move.

The children of the neighborhood made the front room their rendezvous. There they played stories—wonderful stories of Irish soldiers. So, naturally, it wasn't worth while keeping the front room particularly tidy. It was the "children's room."

But when night fell and the children had gone, "Granny" retired to the back room, which was always locked and that was kept neat and clean, for the children were never allowed to go in there. That, then, was the mystery.

AN ORDINANCE TO CONDEMN A PLOT OF GROUND, WITH BUILDINGS AND IMPROVEMENTS THEREON, SITUATED IN THE TWENTY-SECOND WARD, AND TO APPROPRIATE THE SAME FOR PARK AND PLAY-GROUND PURPOSES, AND FOR THE HEALTH AND ENJOYMENT OF THE CITIZENS OF PHILADELPHIA.

Section 1. The Select and Common Councils of the City of Philadelphia do ordain: That the sum of fifty thousand (\$50,000) dollars be appropriated to Item 4, toward the relief of the Department of Public Health leased by the said Department, and the laying of the necessary main sewer, along the same, to be paid to the City Treasurer, drawn on the City Solicitor, for the payment of the expenses of the erection of a temporary sewage pumping station, in the Twenty-second Ward, and the laying of the necessary outlet pipes in Haines Avenue, north, on ground to be leased by the said Department, and the laying of the necessary main sewer, along the same, to be paid to the City Treasurer, drawn on the City Solicitor, for the payment of the expenses of the erection of a temporary sewage pumping station, in the Twenty-second Ward, and the laying of the necessary outlet pipes in Haines Avenue, north, on ground to be leased by the said Department, and the laying of the necessary main sewer, along the same, to be paid to the City Treasurer, drawn on the City Solicitor, for the payment of the expenses of the erection of
