Wheat Prices Fell After Early Rise

European Demand in Last 3 Days Was 3,500,000 Bushels, South African Crop Damaged

CHICAGO, April 25.—Stimulated by a continual foreign demand, wheat prices again rose at the opening of the grain pit today. First sales of May wheat were made at \$1.63 1/2, up 1 cent, while July began the day at \$1.63 1/2, up 1/2 cent.

In the afternoon prices reacted. May fell back to \$1.64, while July lost more than two cents, closing at \$1.57 1/2.

The export business in wheat in the last three days was unexpectedly large. Conservative estimates of the amount of wheat sold, American and Canadian, placed the total at about 3,500,000 bushels.
