DR. RICHMOND WILL NOT PREACH FAREWELL SERMON

Rector of St. John's Episcopal Church Does Not Intend to Vacate Pulpit.

The Rev. George Chalmers Richmond, who is soon to be given a trial before an ecclesiastical court on charges preferred by persons who are trying to unbrook him, and who was given notice by Bishop Rhinelander to discontinue his services as rector of St. John's Protestant Episcopal Church, 53 and Brown streets, on or before June 1, does not intend to preach a farewell sermon tomorrow.

He says that he intends to fight to retain the rectorship and that he does not expect to be removed from his work with St. John's. He will, therefore, preach both morning and evening tomorrow without any intimation that he contemplates the last day he shall preach to his congregation.

Before Judge Ferguson, in Common Pleas Court, next Wednesday he expects to prove that the vestry that stands back of him and wants him to remain as rector is the legal vestry of the church and that the "curators vestry" which is trying to have him removed has no authority to act against him, he says.
