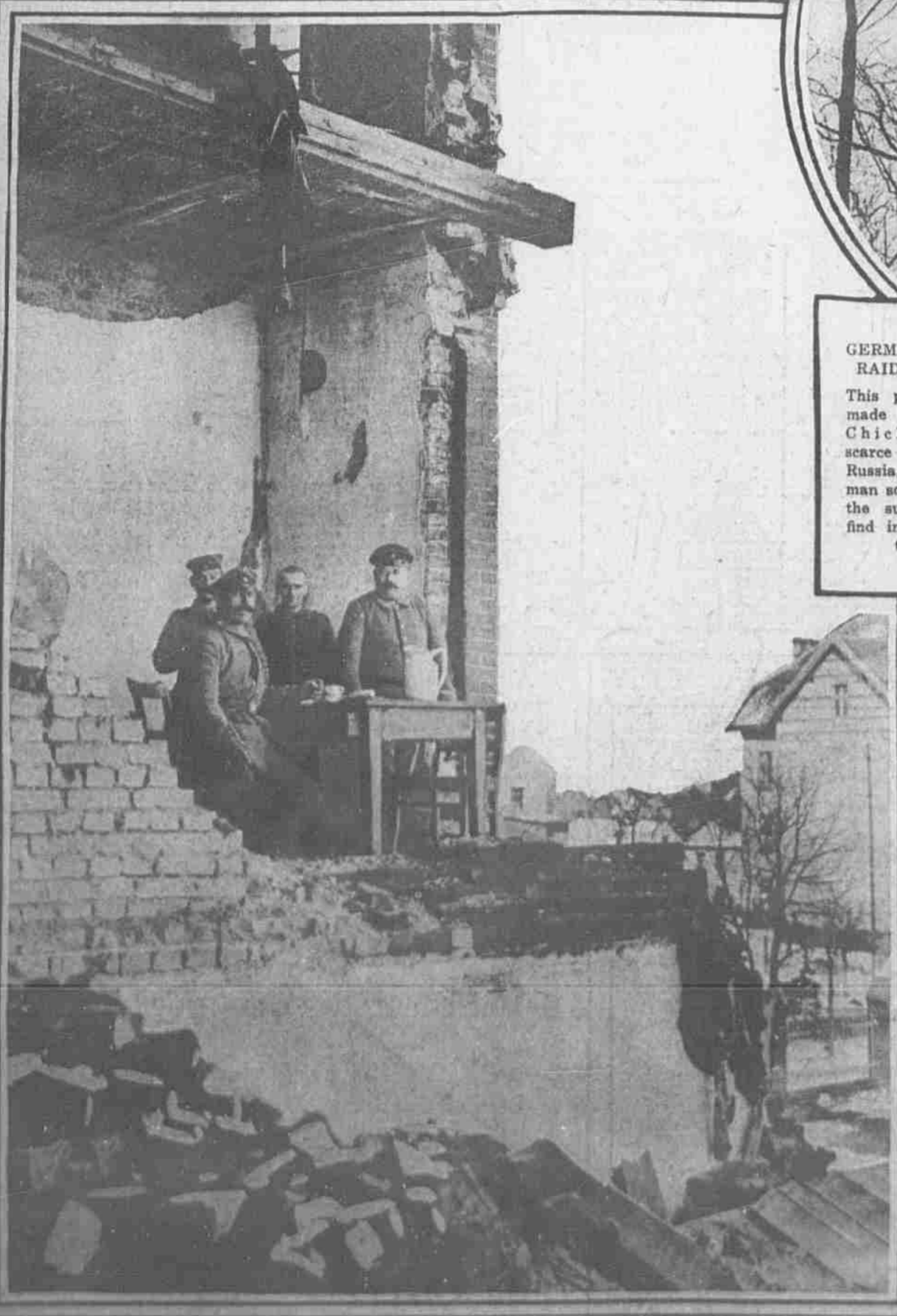
IN ONE OF HIS OWN "LIDS"
