

CHARGE OF FRENCH TROOPS ON HILL POSITION HELD BY GERMANS AND HUNGARIAN CAVALRY IN MASSED DRIVE AGAINST RETREATING RUSSIANS

The upper photograph illustrates one of the most dramatic incidents in the recent ferorious fighting around the hills of Carency. It shows a company of French infantry, led by their captain, dashing to the assault of Notre Dame de Lorette was rated as one of the most brilliant achievements of the campaign in that region. French troops ever have had the reputation of being at their best in the charge.
