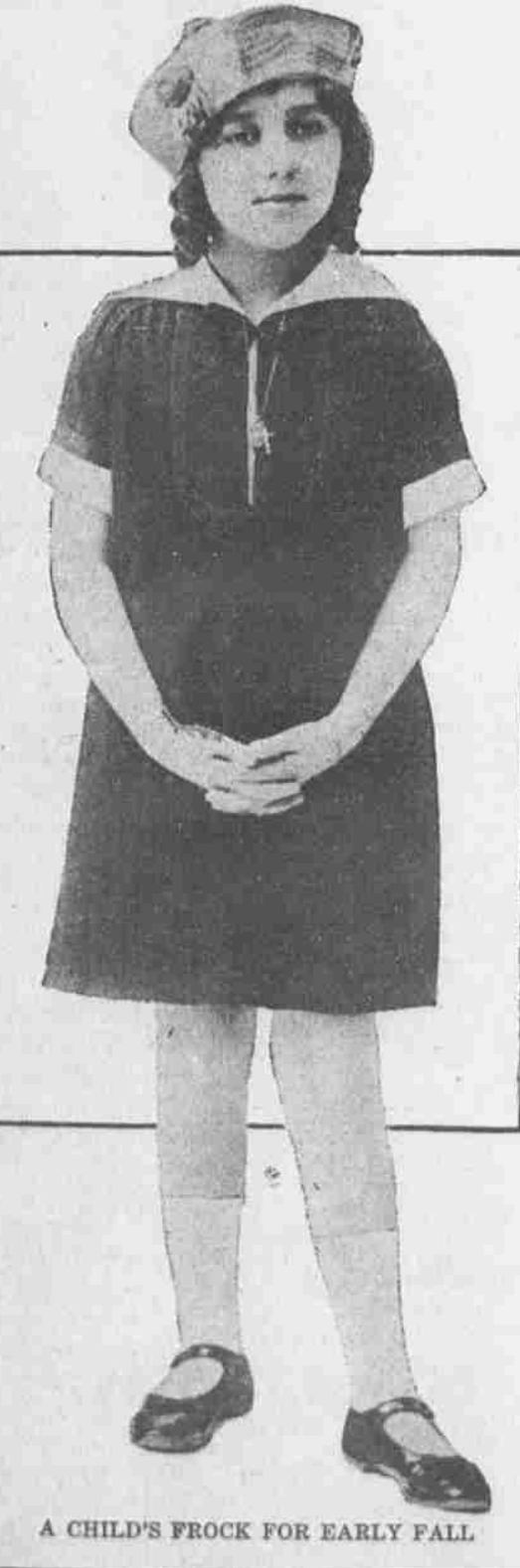
These selfsame critics entirely overlook the fact that those catastrophes—and engagements without love on both sides are catastrophes—happen through the thoughtless manner in which some men propose.

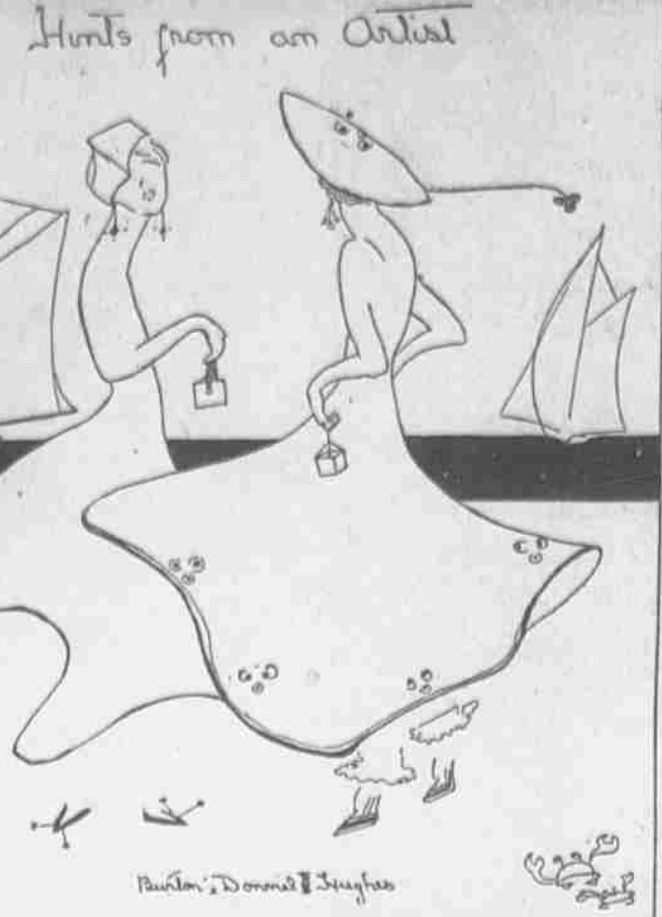
THE WISE WOMAN GUARDS HER SKIN AGAINST DUST THESE WARM DAYS
