A NORD DI GORIZIA

ROMA, 22 Ottobre. Le notizie che giungono dal fronte di battaglia italiano sono eccellenti. Gli italiani hanno fatto in questi ultimi due giorni oltre 12,000 prigionieri, uccisi, in molti punti del Tirolo, della Carnia e del Carso il nemico è stato cacciato dalle sue posizioni e sconfitto e gli italiani gli hanno preso una grande quantità di munizioni e di altro materiale da guerra.

Nella Valle del Fella i nostri reparti hanno compiuto averre infliggendo al nemico seri danni e prendendogli armi e munizioni. Il villaggio di Leopoldsdorf è stato incendiato a raso al nemico è stato cacciato al monte. Le nostre truppe hanno preso in un colpo solo un intero reparto di artiglieria, le nostre truppe intralzano un attacco nella mattina del 22 corrente contro le posizioni nemiche fortemente protette.

Alcuni sul Carso forti linee nemiche sono state sfondate in parecchi punti, reparti nemici sono stati annientati o dispersi e le nostre truppe hanno fatto prigionieri 65 ufficiali e 124 soldati austriaci.

SLAVS CAPTURED IN THREE DAYS

Russians Pursue Violent Attacks Close to Galician Border. HALT RIGA MOVEMENT. LONDON, Oct. 22.—Another Russian success, this time in the far south, close to the Galician frontier, resulting in the capture of 7000 prisoners, with some war material, is announced by the Russian War Office.

This makes the third time in three consecutive days that the Russians have struck the German line, no two of the objectives selected being within 100 miles of each other.

The first attack was made three days ago, at Czartorysk, where the Riga River is crossed by the Kovel-Kieff railway.

The Riga region, where the German have based their latest hopes of success, is proving a new source of disappointment to them, says the Petrograd correspondent of the Daily News.
