

BULLMOOSE QUIT RING; WOULD HELP BEAT DEMOCRATS

Progressives Now Openly Invite Merger With Republican Party

HOPE TO NAME COLONEL

CHICAGO, Jan. 12.—The Progressive party, through its National Committee in session here, openly invites amalgamation with the Republicans in order to defeat the Democratic administration.

In a straightforward statement of principles, voted by George W. Perkins, chairman, the way is opened for the party to merge with the Republicans as early as the date of the Progressive National Convention, the same as that fixed by the Republicans, and also in Chicago.

The official statement bears the signature of national committee men at the Chicago conference, and it is understood to embody exactly the views entertained by Colonel Roosevelt.

"We are all hoping," said Mr. Perkins, with deliberation, "that both parties will agree on somebody, and it need not necessarily be Mr. Roosevelt."

HOPE TO NAME ROOSEVELT

The real purpose of bringing the Progressive Convention to Chicago is to name Roosevelt for President in June.

"In this crisis of our country," Mr. Perkins explained, "the developments of a few weeks may radically change everything. It is now only January. The conventions will be held in June. By that time many names might be considered. No one can tell who may develop as the crisis develops. But, I repeat, we are all hoping that both parties may agree on the same candidate."

Justice Hughes apparently has considerable strength among the Progressives, both in the West and here. Some committee men who attended the meeting were frankly for him as the second choice next to Roosevelt. But nine out of 19 believe Roosevelt will be the Republican—and therefore Progressive—nominee.

Medill McCormick, of Chicago, it was intimated, will be one of the principal intermediaries between the Progressives and Republicans in their negotiations for a compromise.

Volunteers to Build Darby Tabernacle

When Nicholas Hemming starts his evangelistic campaign in Darby on February 11, he will not have to criticize the congregation in the tabernacle for giving small donations towards expense. There will not have been any expense.
