

SOCIALISTS ACTIVE IN PEACE CAMPAIGN

Representatives of Allies and Teutons Seek Common Ground to End War

PARIS, Jan. 17. Leaders of the Socialists who are trying to bring about a cessation of hostilities declare that a congress is being made. A strong peace propaganda is being directed by Socialists from the Hague. The most important feature of the socialistic peace movement is that Socialists of England, France and Italy are in touch with Austro-Hungarian and German Socialists and are striving for a common ground on which to work. The next move in the socialistic campaign is to try to influence the respective belligerent Governments toward peace in the following directions: First. Limitation of armament. Second. Reformation of diplomacy in order to eliminate secret treaties. Third. Extension of parliamentary control over governmental acts, so that the people will know just what their Governments are doing. Fourth. Compulsory arbitration of all international disputes. European reformers are hoping for the establishment of a great international socialistic union at the conclusion of the war which will have power of such widespread extent as to prevent another such conflagration in the future.

FUNERAL OF DR. S. H. BOYER

Late Minister Will Be Laid to Rest This Afternoon

The Rev. Dr. Samuel H. Boyer, who died on Saturday after an illness of several weeks, will be buried this afternoon after services in All Saints' Church, 11th and Snyder streets. His widow, Mrs. Sophie Boyer, is so ill that she will be unable to attend the funeral. She will be suffering from the grip for six weeks and went to bed before her husband became sick. Nervousness due to the shock of Doctor Boyer's death, has increased the seriousness of her illness.

Doctor Boyer is survived, in addition to his widow, by two sons and a daughter, Mrs. Luther S. Green. Before his retirement from the ministry, six years ago, he was rector of the Church of the Holy Spirit. At that time this church was merged with All Saints' Church.
