### CARNEGIE STEEL ADVANCES PLATE PRICES \$10 A TON

#### Bars and Shapes Also Boosted-Demand Large

mand Large FITTSHURGH, Feb. 23.—The Carnegie Steel Company has advanced the ware-house prices of plates \$10 per ton and hars and shapes \$5 a ton. Structural shapes are new quoted at \$2.95 and steel parts \$2.50 per 100 pounds f. o. b. Waverly warehouse. Shrapnel bars three inches and over are advanced to 4.55c a pound from the warehouse. Although many premiums are being paid to independent steel manufacturers for bars and plates, the United States Steel Corporation is taking business \$2.25 a pound Pittsburgh. It is stated that some husiness has been booked by the leading interests covering the first quarter of 1917, and some contracts have been taken even beyond that period.

Activity in the rail market continues. The Chicago, Indianapolis and Louisville Railway has placed an order for 7000 tons of rails with the United States Steel Corporation. Small contracts placed re-cently aggregate 18,000 tons. It is reported that many orders are pending and a number of inquiries are in the market, including the 15,000 tons for the Alaska Engineering Commission, bids for which will be received on March 6. The com-mission also is inquiring for spikes and tie-plates.

There are many iron interests who hold to the belief that pig iron will be scarce in a short time, and that considerable difficulty will be experienced by buyers

in getting their business on the books of the various companies. It has become known that the United States Steel Cor-poration is not now making any sales of iron for future deliveries.
