

CROP NEWS CAUSED COVERING IN WHEAT

Market Fluctuated Erratically. Large Flour Exports Reported

CHICAGO, Feb. 25.—Covering promptly by unfavorable crop news and a let-up in a liquidation brought about a firmer start to the wheat market here today, after it had shown a good deal of nervousness and irregularity. After a higher and considerable selling weakness at the start, but the demand finally overtook the selling orders and the losses were wiped out.

NEW LOW LEVELS FOR COTTON: SOUTHERN SELLING A FACTOR

The West Was Also Liquidating and Spots Were Being Hedged. NEW YORK, Feb. 25.—A mixed start was made in the cotton market this morning. The undertone was steady, with nearby cottons showing losses of 2 to 3 points, while October and December were 1 point higher, but January dropped 2 points.
