CHESTER MAYOR OUSTS PREDECESSOR'S PROTEGES

Dismisses Sealers of Weights William J. Leary and Robert Watson

CHESTER, Pa., April 20.—Mayor McDowell has dismissed William J. Leary and Robert Watson as sealers of weights and measures. He has not intimated who he will appoint to succeed them.

Mayor Ward named Watson as Highway Commissioner and Leary as Sealer. The commission form of government abolished Watson's office, so Ward appointed Watson to succeed Leary.

Leary fought the case, the Court sustaining him, ruling that he could not be removed for political reasons and that no charges had been brought against him. The Court also said that the Mayor could appoint more than one sealer. Both men have been serving nearly two years.
