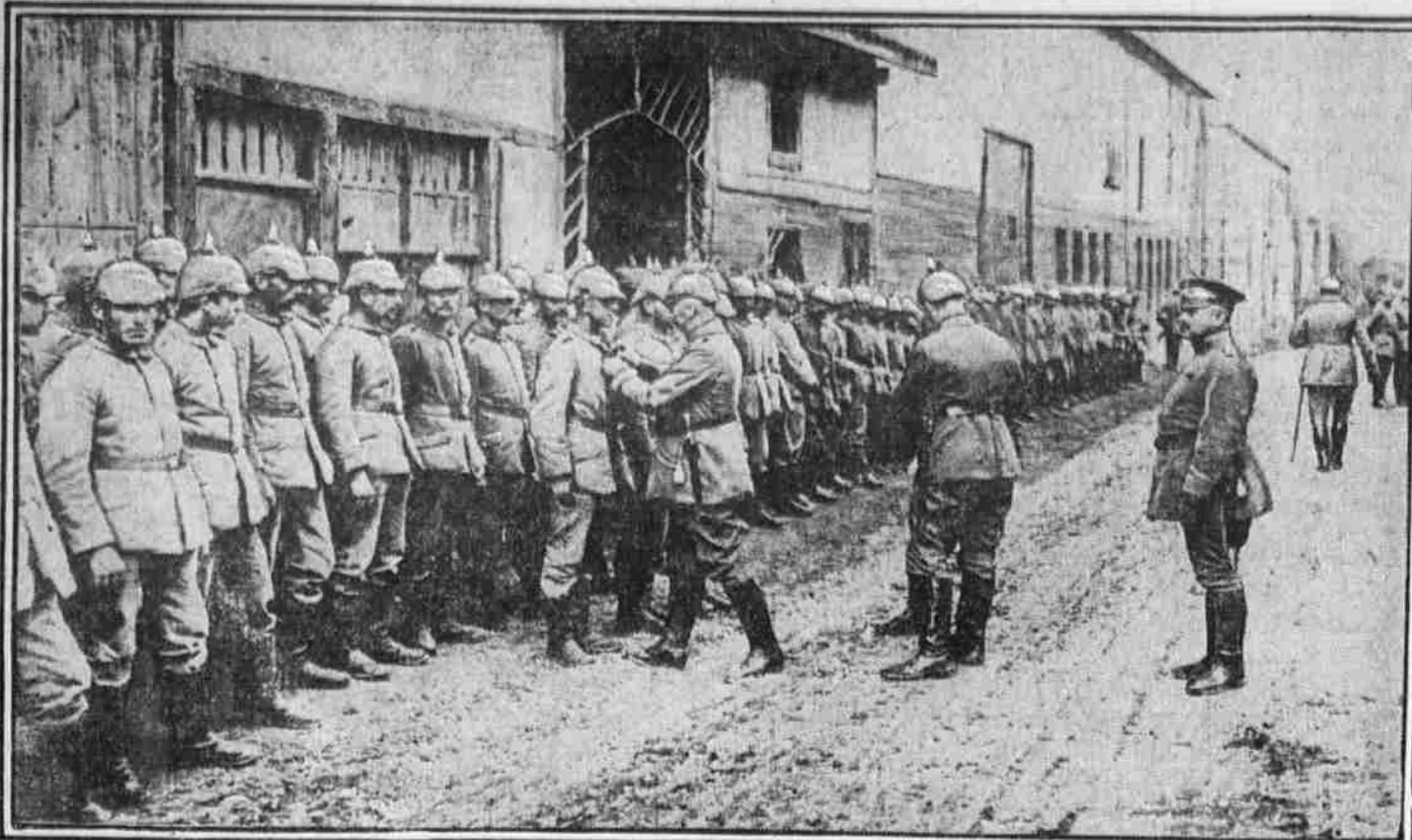

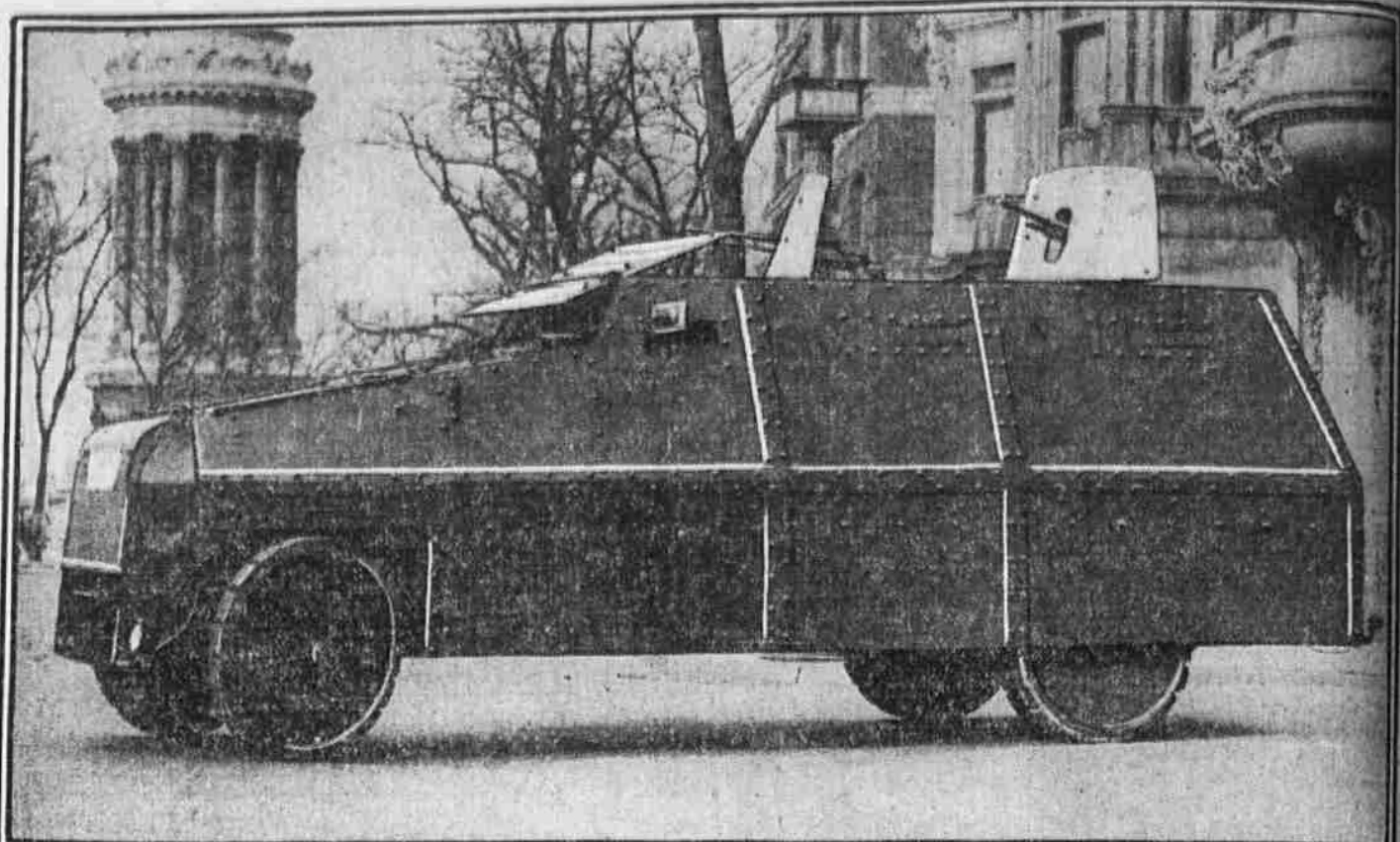
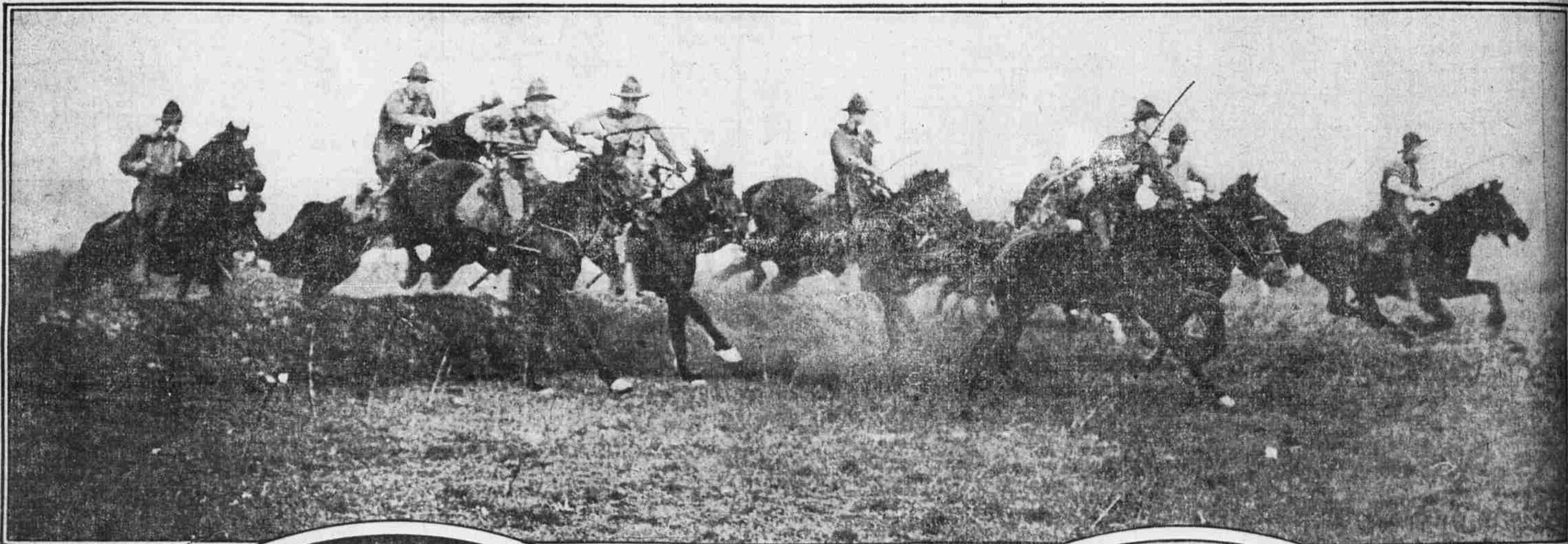

Cadets of the Pennsylvania Military College, of Chester, in cavalry charge on force defending munitions plants at Eddystone.

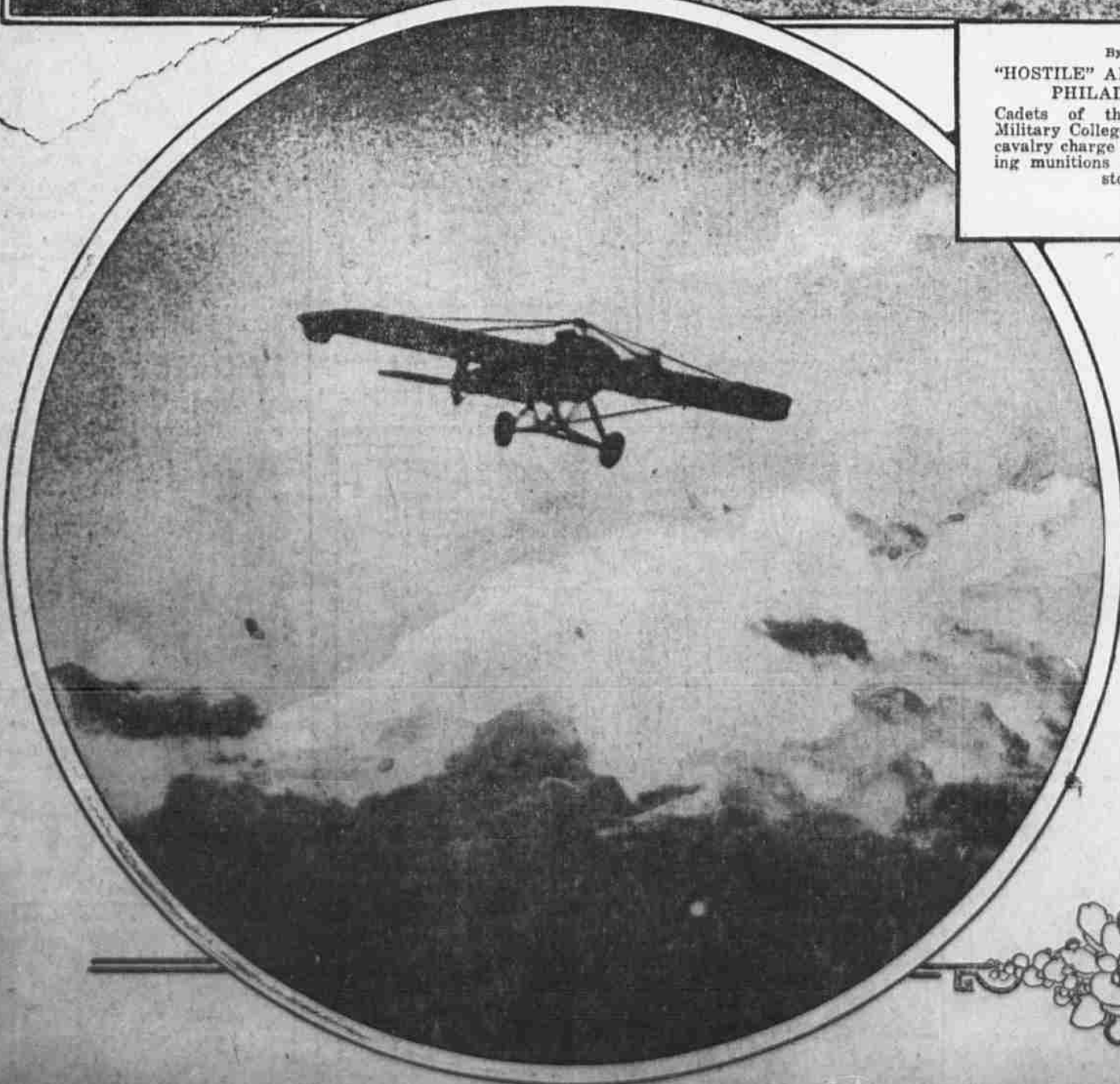
