

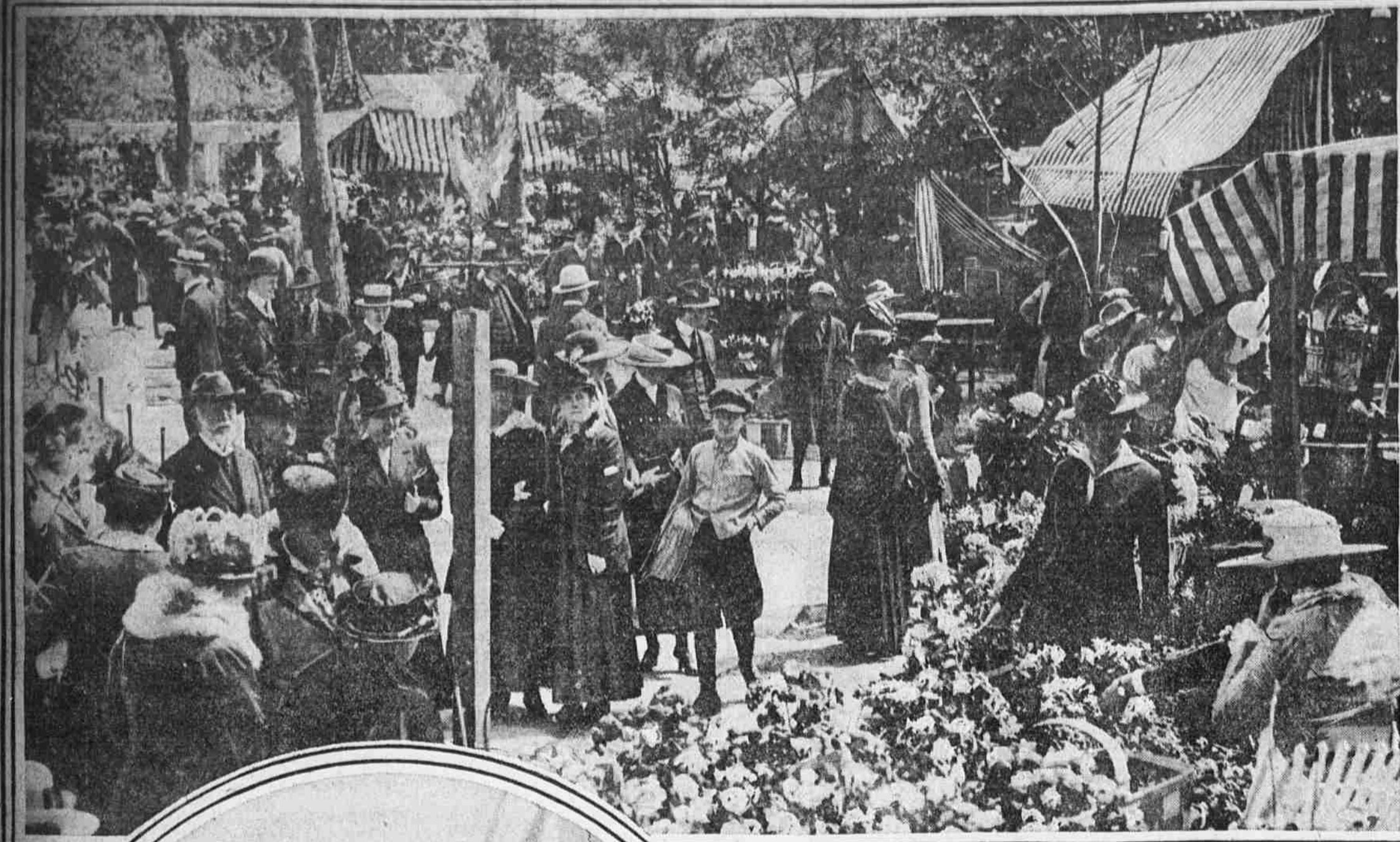

The Rev. Dr. David Tully, of Media, Pa., who preaches in Upper Darby every Sunday, though he is 98 years old.

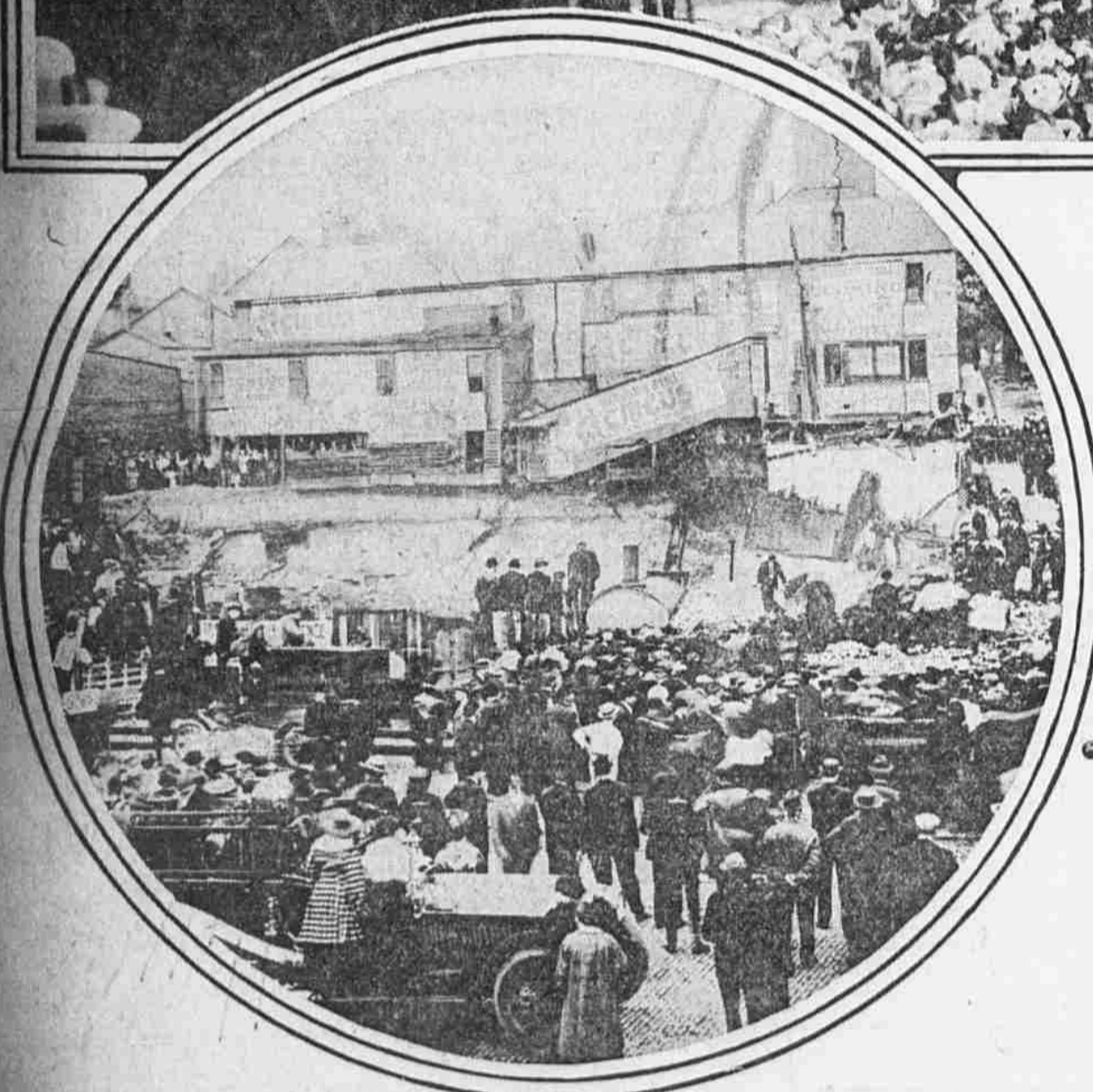

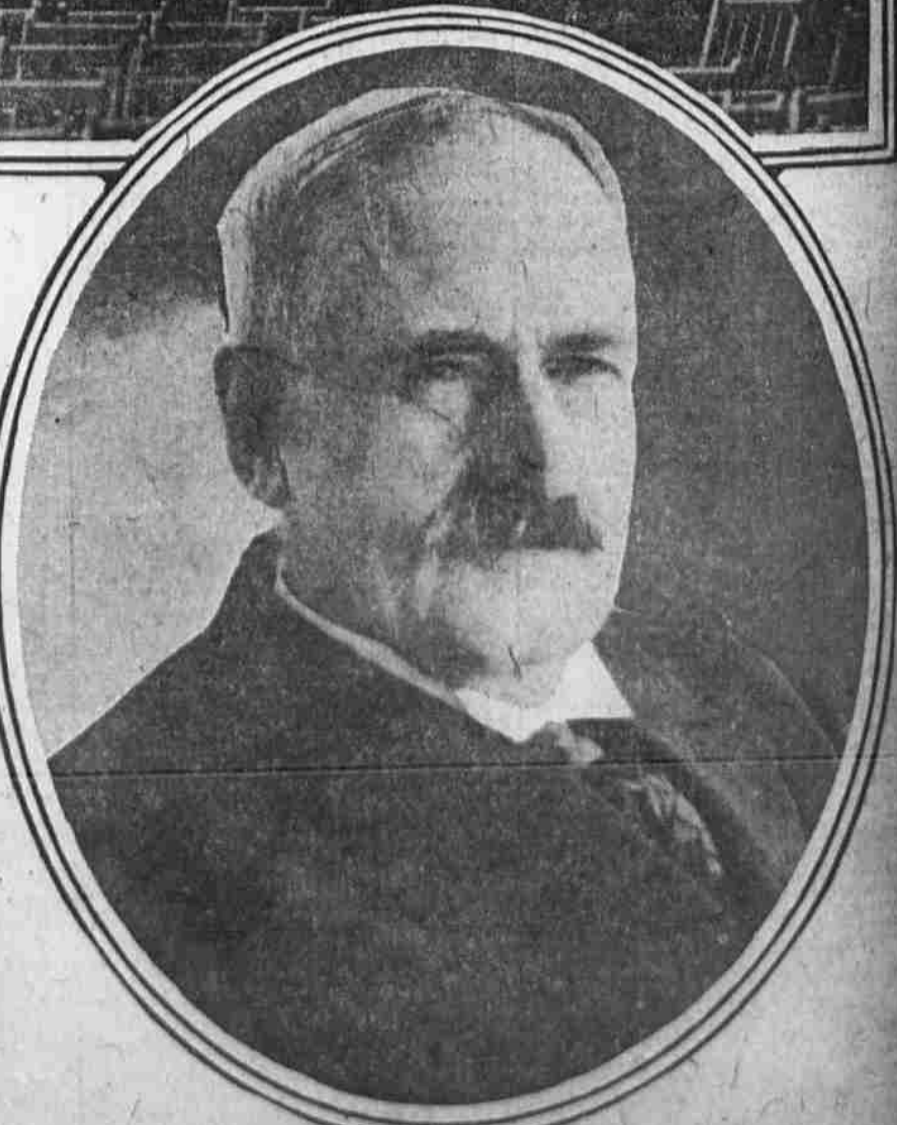
