

SHACKLETON SEEKING SHIP TO RESCUE STRANDED MEN
Appears for Argentine Ship, But Vessel Is Not in Condition

BUENOS AIRES, June 28.—Lieutenant Sir Ernest Shackleton, whose efforts to rescue the main body of his Antarctic expedition, left on Elephant Island, proved futile when the steamship furnished by the Uruguayan Government for the purpose met

with adverse ice conditions, has requested the dispatch to Elephant Island of the Argentine Antarctic steamship Uruguay, which resumed the Swedish expedition in 1903.

The Minister of Marine states, however, that it is impossible to send the Uruguay, because she is not in serviceable condition. No other suitable vessel in Argentina is available for the work, and it is feared here the chances of rescuing the stranded party this season are slim.

HONORS FOR MACCABEANS
Swords to Be Presented to Jacob D. Lit and Isadore Stern

HELD UP FOR \$500,000
American Oil Operator in Mexico Threatened by Carranza

ROCKFORD, Tex., June 28.—Eighty-eight American refugees brought from Tampico yesterday have been released from quarantine. About 75 of the party are employees of the Mexican Petroleum Company and its subsidiary, the Huasteca Petroleum Company.

According to the refugees, the Carranza authorities at Tampico have made a normal demand on W. H. Green, acting general superintendent of the Huasteca Petroleum Company, for a sum equivalent to \$500,000. This money was ostensibly to be used for the protection of the company's oil wells and pipe lines. Mr. Green, according to the refugees, refused to accede to the demand and was threatened with imprisonment unless the money was paid over.
