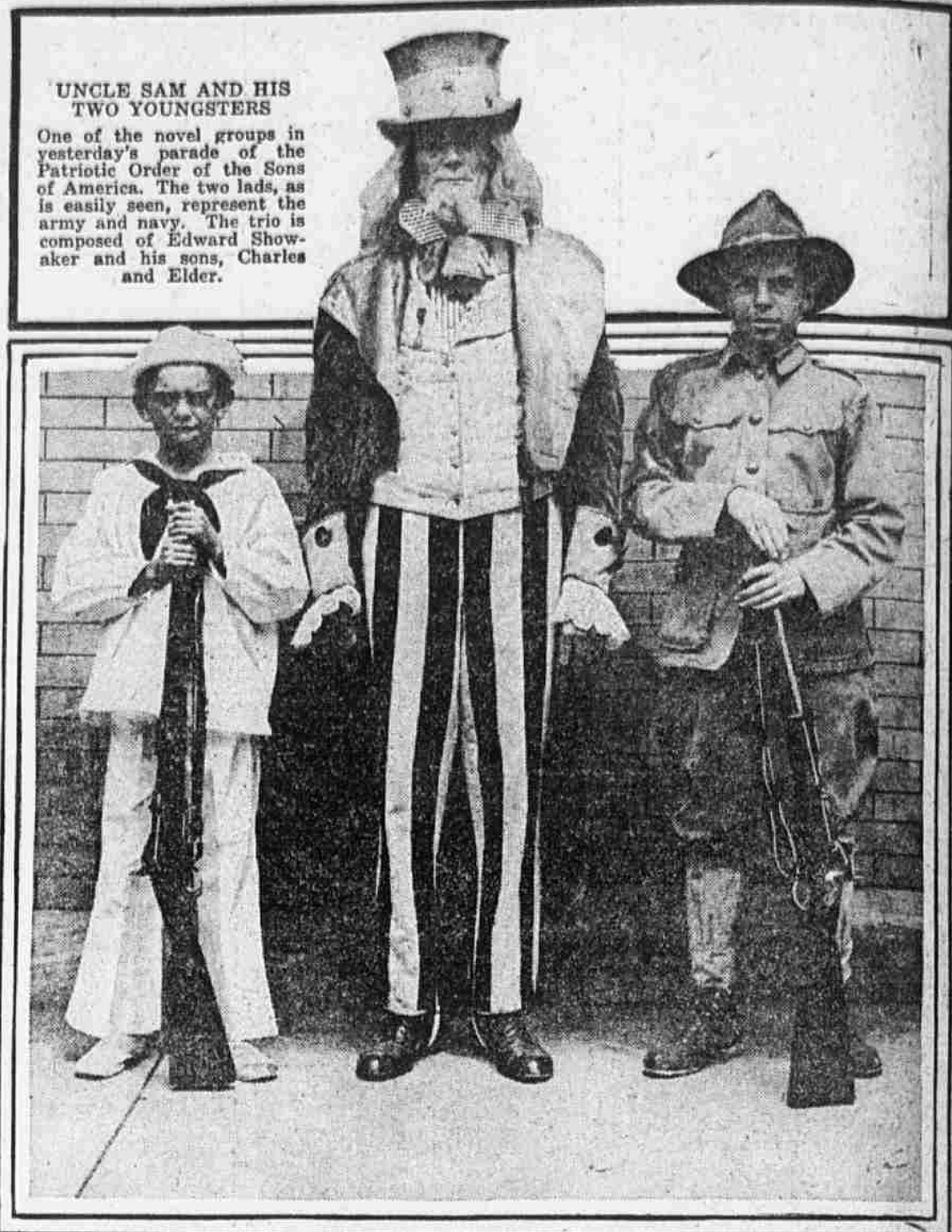

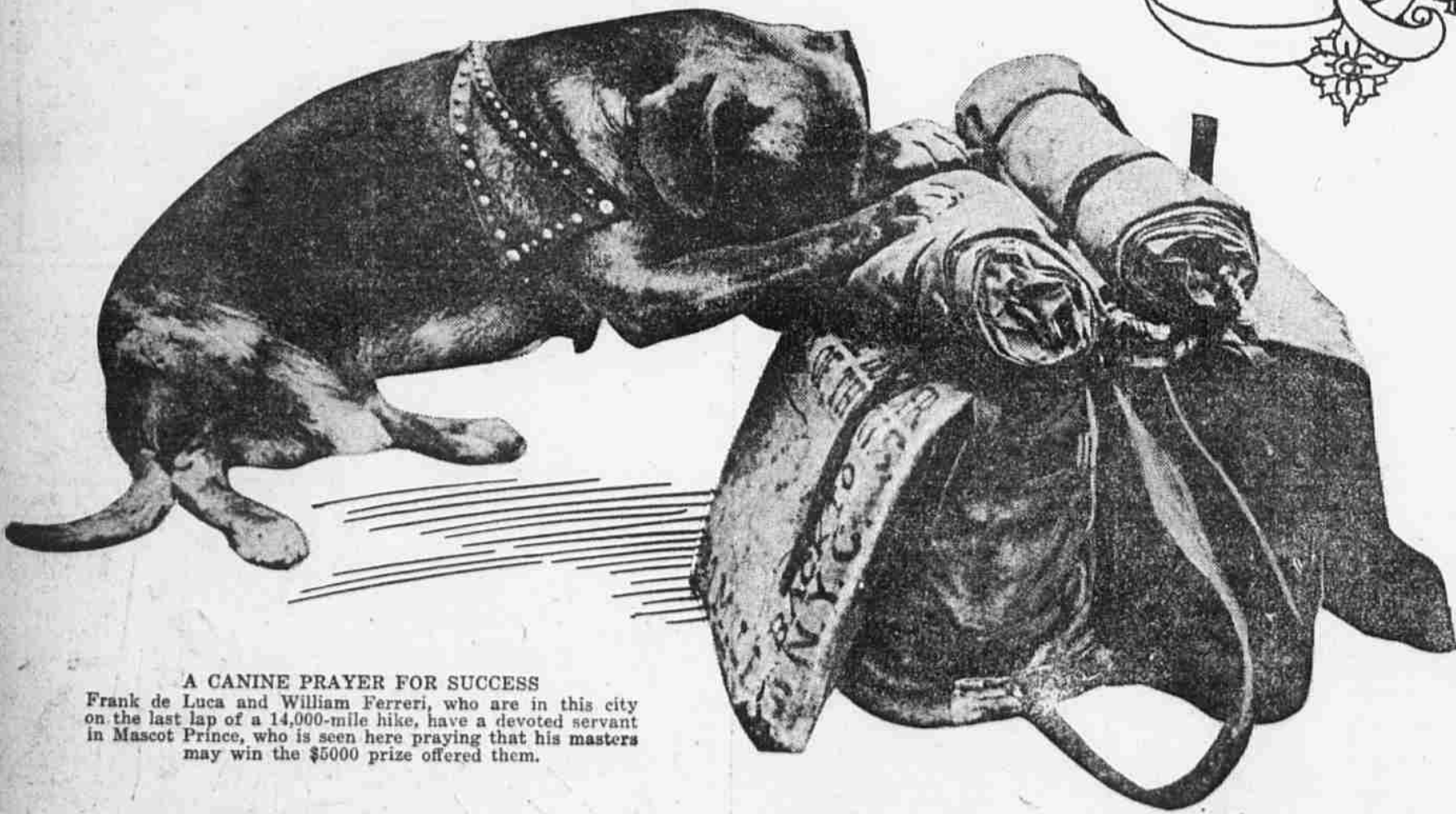
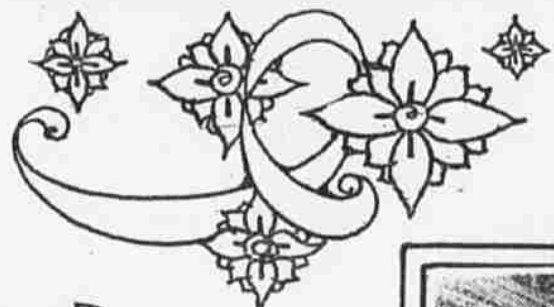

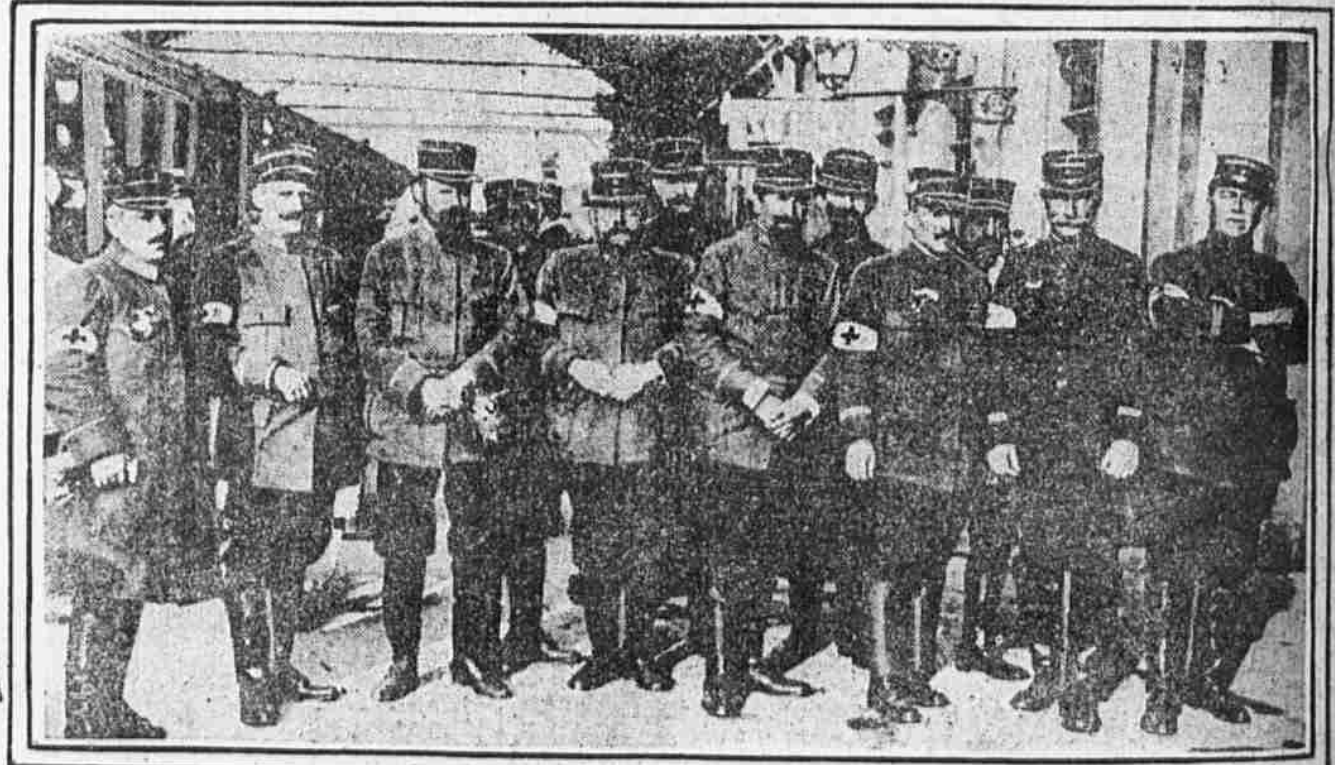
UNCLE SAM AND HIS TWO YOUNGSTERS
