



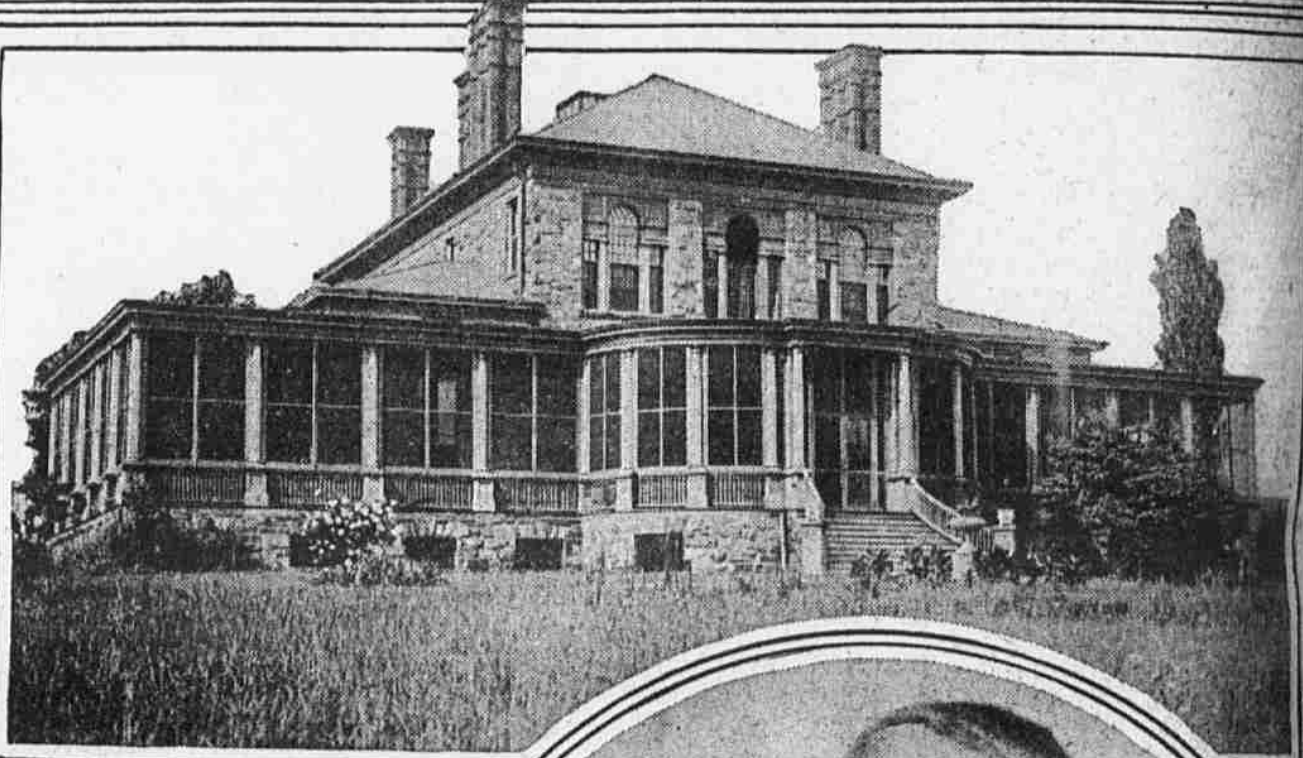

She couldn't leave her pet in the hot city, so, carefully guarded against pneumonia, she shares the seashore vacation of his fair owner.



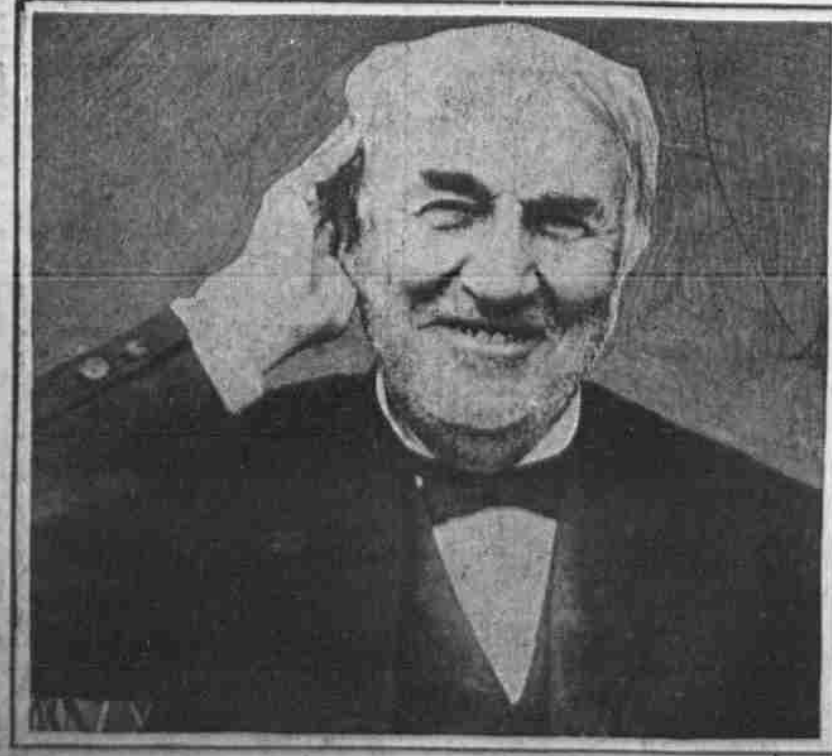
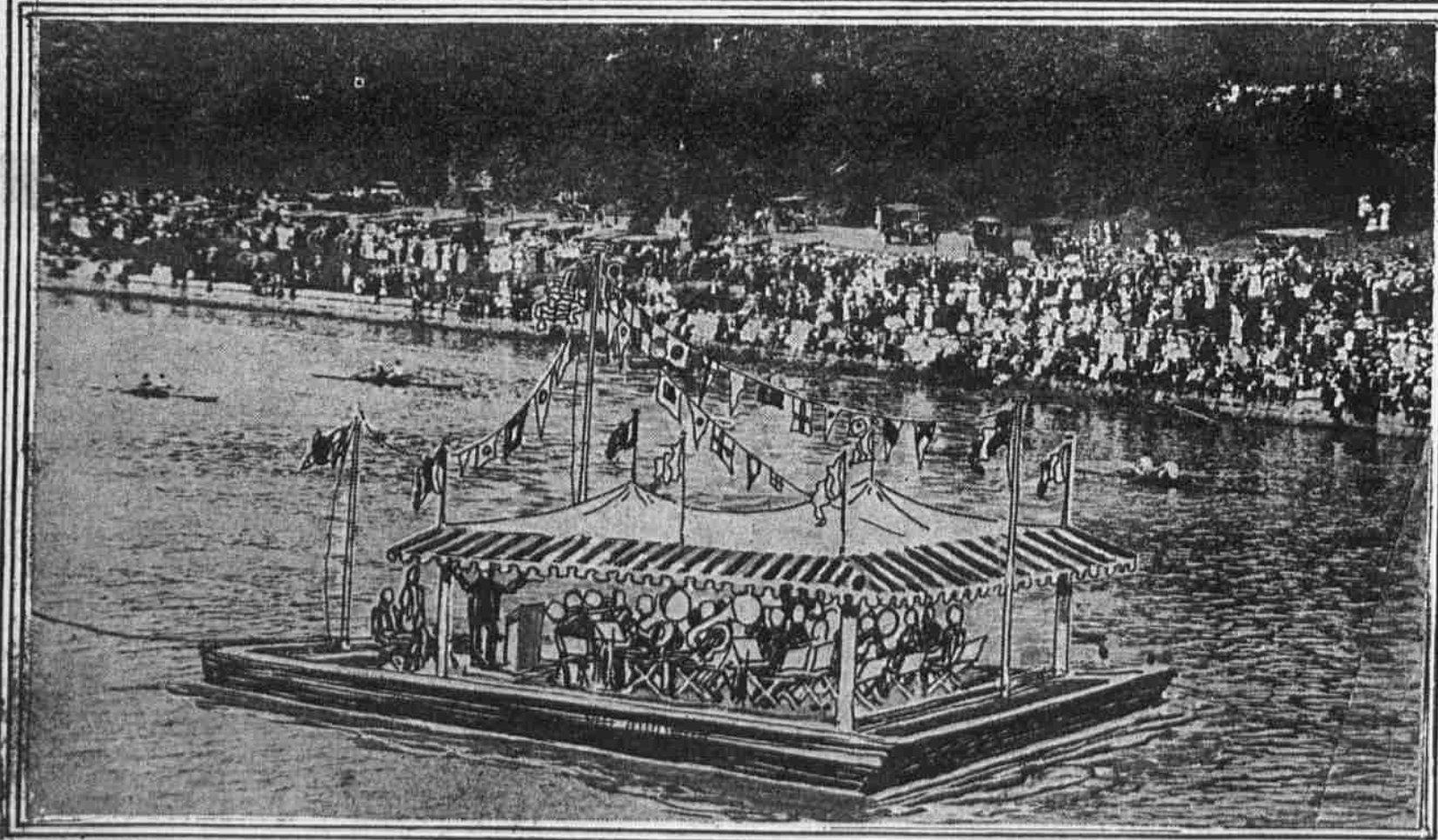
THEY NO LONGER TRIP THE LIGHT FANTASTIC ON THE SIDEWALKS

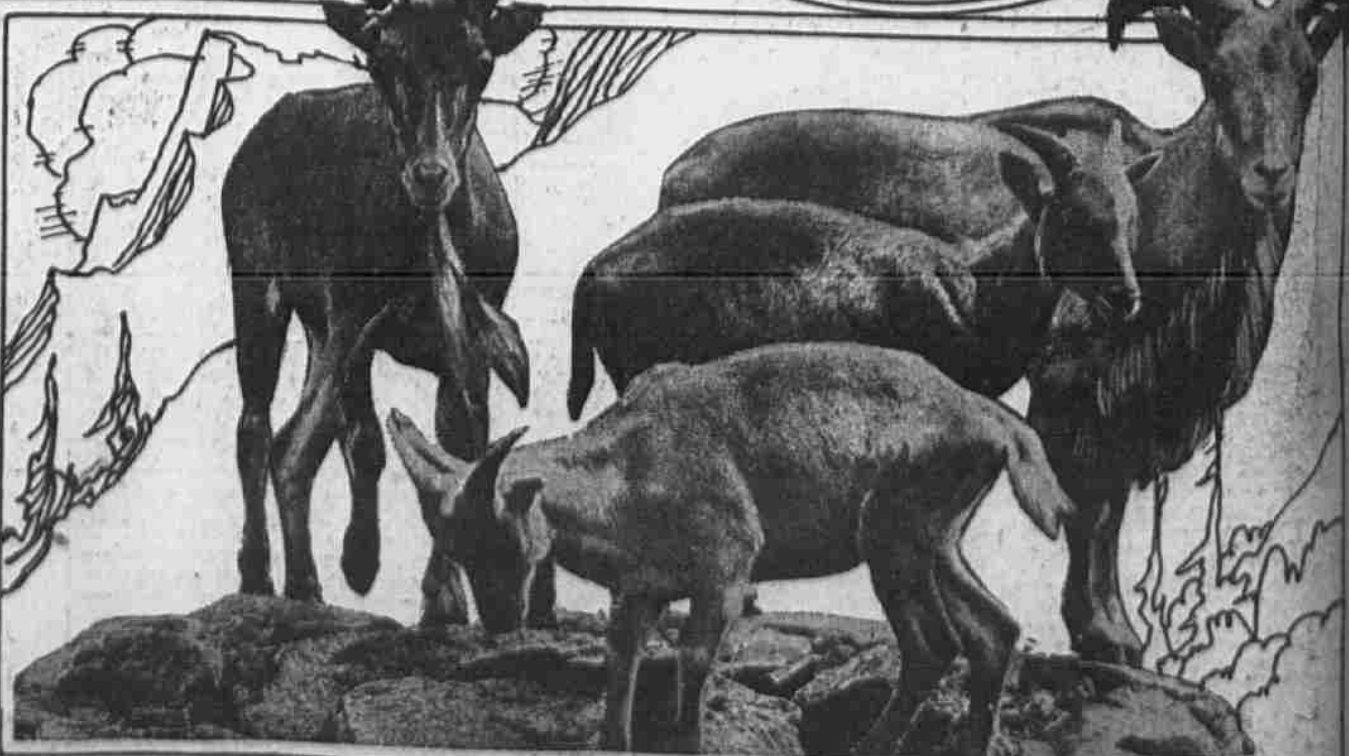
WHAT WE MAY SEE ALONG THE SCHUYLKILL'S BANKS
