






WAR IS NOT ALL THAT SHERMAN SAID IT WAS

Miss Dorothy Rice has offered her services to the United States to serve with the army zero corps now on the border. If accepted, she will be the first female aviator to see service.




TYPES OF MEN IN RUMANIAN ARMY
