For Fifty Guests

- The following quantities have been tested by housewives and found reliable: One pound of chocolate makes two gallons. For this amount two and one-half pounds of loaf sugar and two quarts of cream. Each quart yields twenty-five spoonfuls of whipped cream.

Prune Cream Cake

Half a cup of butter with one cup of sugar. Add the yolks of three eggs, half a cup of milk, two cups of flour, two spoonfuls of baking powder and the stiffly beaten whites. Bake in two layers.

Baked Sardines

Drain a can of the fish and lay in a baking dish. Mix two tablespoons of butter, four tablespoons of bread crumbs, two eggs and two tablespoons of hot water. Cover the fish with this mixture and bake fifteen minutes.

Red Sauce

Thirty large tomatoes, ten onions, four large or eight small red peppers, one quart vinegar, one-half cup salt, one-half cup sugar. Chop all fine and boil two hours.
