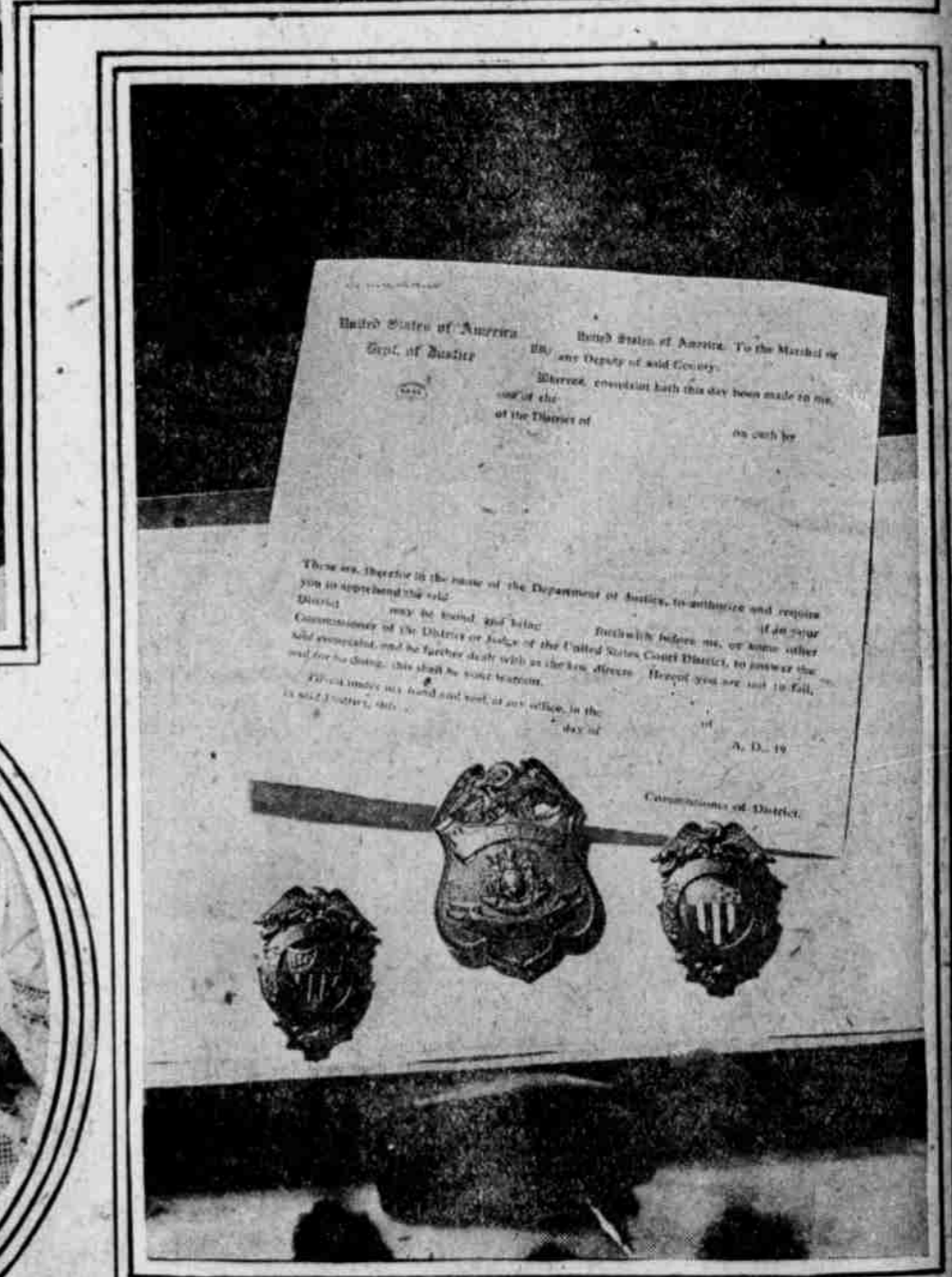




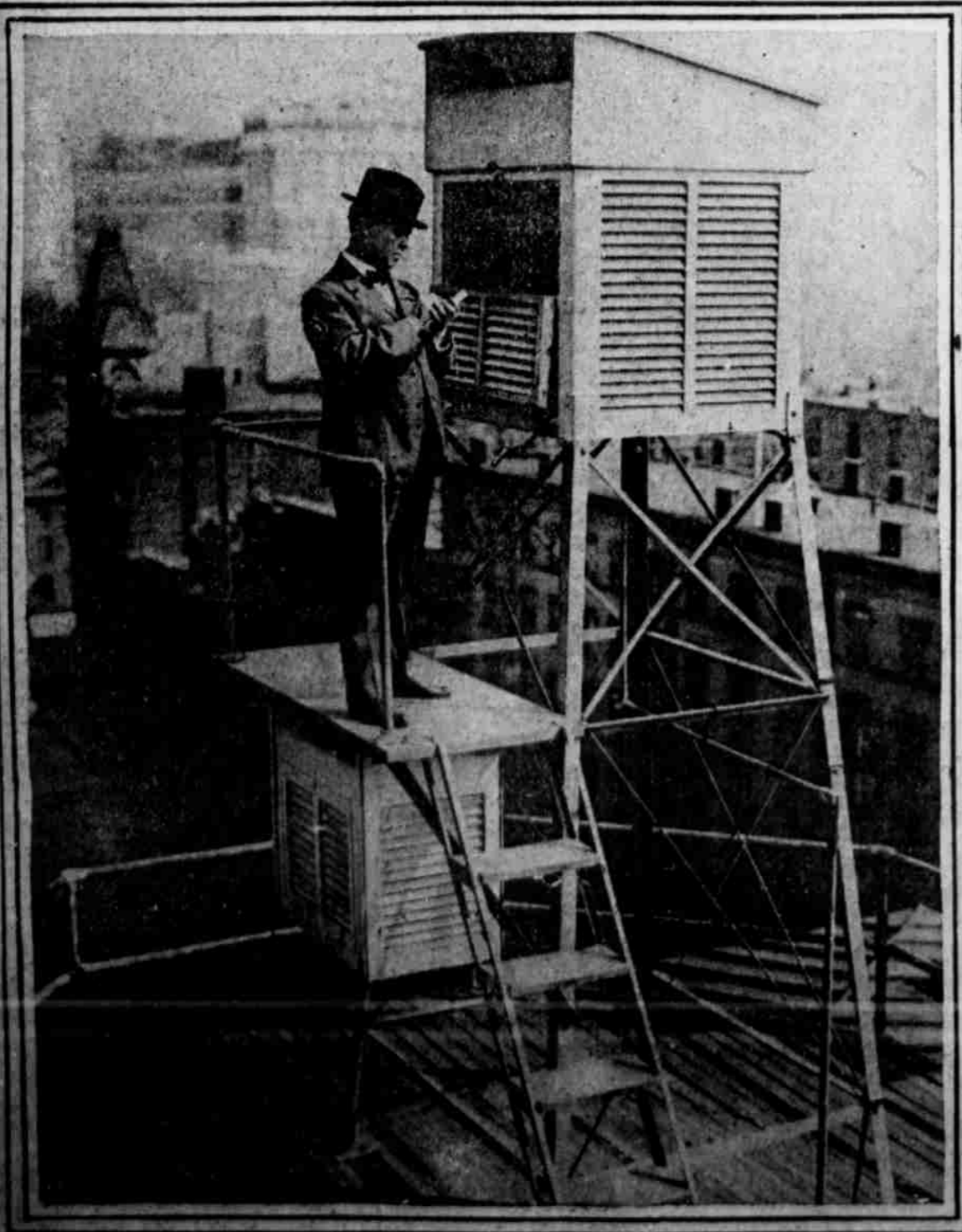

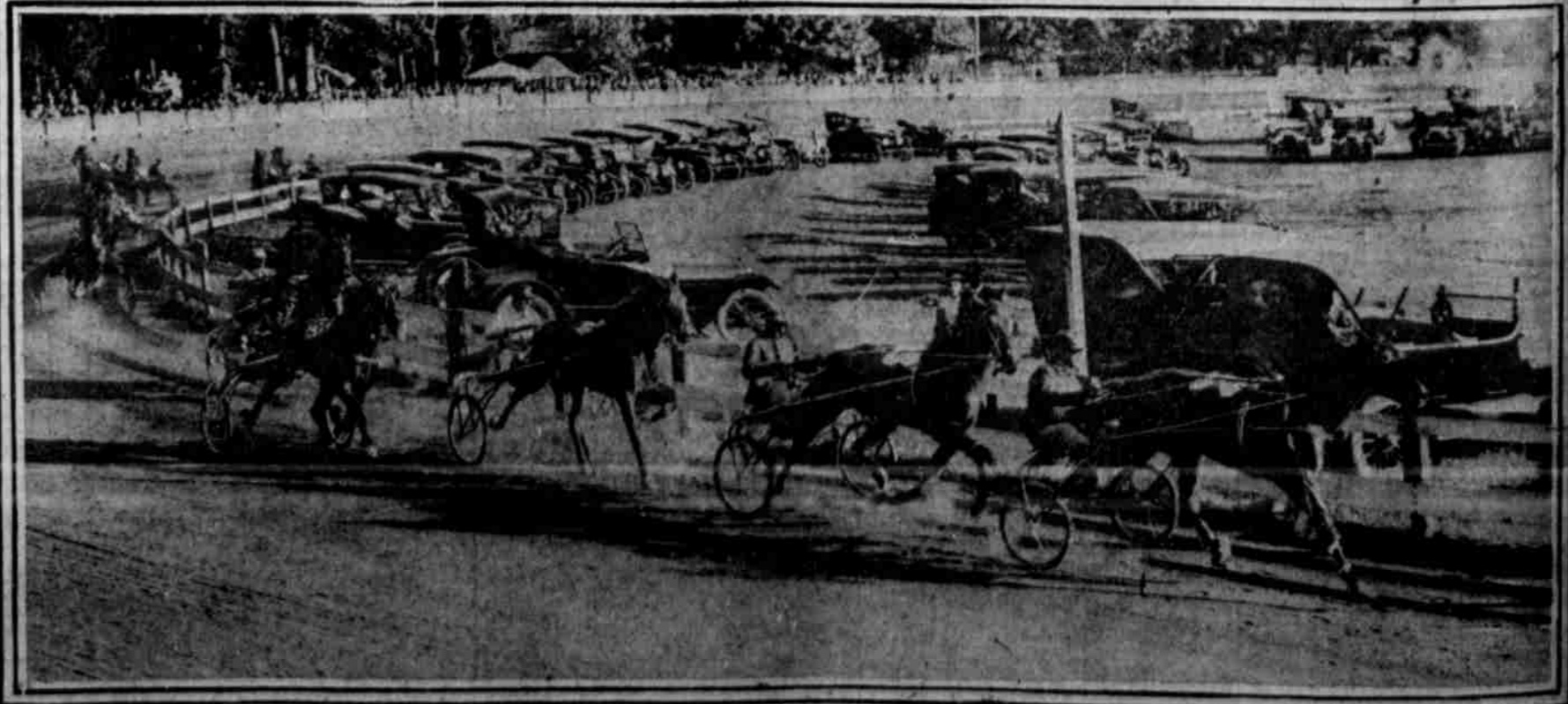
CONSECRATION OF MONSIGNOR McDEVITT AS THE NEW BISHOP OF HARRISBURG
