

JAPAN SEEKS WORLD TRADE; IGNORES WAR, JUDGE GARY ASSERTS

Nation Not Taking Sides in Conflict Since It Has Territory Formerly Occupied by Germany

WATCHING U. S. ELECTION

CHICAGO, Sept. 29.—Japan is bending her every effort to become a great trade factor, and apparently is paying little attention to the war, according to Judge Albert H. Gary, chairman of the United States Steel Corporation, who came here today on his way back East after a visit to the Orient.

"The Japanese are going along as if there were no war," he said. "They have taken up extensively the manufacture of goods stopped in the belligerent countries by the war. Japan is busy making clothing and shoes and is becoming a great commercial factor. I don't believe the Japanese are taking sides in the war, now that they have possession of the territory formerly occupied by Germany.

JAPANESE SUBSIDY GRANTED TO COMPETE WITH U. S. IN EAST

Bounty Contemplated for Electrical Machinery Export Trade

WASHINGTON, Sept. 29.—American trade efforts in the Far East are to be confronted with competition directed and subsidized by the Japanese Government, according to dispatches reaching Washington today. The reports say that Japan contemplates granting a bounty to the electrical machinery industry in Japan for engaging in the export trade in Russia, China and British India, where American exporters are already fighting for the markets.
